15	Section 1. The act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), referred

- 5 (b) Salons opened prior to September 15, 1976, which have <--
- 6 been operating with one cosmetologist must have sufficient booth
- 7 space to properly install equipment with regard to the health
- 8 <u>and safety of the patrons of the licensed cosmetology salon. The</u>
- 9 booth space shall be a minimum of ten feet by twelve feet or one
- 10 hundred twenty square feet with sixty square feet for each
- 11 additional cosmetologist. The board, after examination of the
- 12 <u>salon's layout may grant a variance from the booth space</u>
- 13 <u>requirements which the board believes is reasonable.</u>
- 14 Section 2. Section 12.1 of the act is amended to read:
- 15 Section 12.1. Temporary Licenses. (a) Upon payment of the
- 16 required fee, a temporary license may be issued to any applicant-
- 17 who is eligible for admission to a cosmetologist's examination
- 18 or to the examination for any of the limited licenses. An-
- 19 applicant who is thus licensed shall practice only under the
- 20 supervision of a licensed teacher or cosmetologist, or under the
- 21 supervision of the holder of a corresponding limited license,
- 22 until the time of the next scheduled examination. Temporary
- 23 licenses are granted for a nine-month period.
- 24 (b) Upon payment of a fee set by the board and not to exceed
- 25 <u>one hundred dollars (\$100), a temporary license may be issued to</u>
- 26 a cosmetology salon that has submitted an application for an
- 27 <u>initial salon_license. To be eliqible for a temporary license, a_</u>
- 28 cosmetology salon shall employ a licensed cosmetologist who has
- 29 been practicing for at least three years and can only employ
- 30 themselves while operating under the temporary salon license. A

1 temporary salon license shall only be valid for ninety days.

2 Section $\frac{3}{2}$ 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
