## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 62 (Procurement) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, in contract clauses and preference provisions,
- 3 further providing for definitions, for contract provisions
- and for funding.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Paragraphs (4) and (13) of the definition of
- 8 "energy conservation measure" in section 3752 of Title 62 of the
- 9 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the section
- 10 is amended by adding definitions to read:
- 11 § 3752. Definitions.
- 12 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 13 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 14 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 15 \* \* \*
- "Energy conservation measure." A program, facility
- 17 alteration or technology upgrade designed to reduce energy,
- 18 water, wastewater or other consumption or operating costs. The
- 19 term may include, without limitation:

(4) Heating, ventilating or air conditioning system
modifications [or], extension of systems to new or renovated
areas or system replacements.
* * *
(13) [Indoor air quality improvements.] Systems that
provide indoor air quality improvements or improved climate
control.
* * *
"Energy-related cost savings." As follows:
(1) A cost saving, except for an energy saving, that
results from the implementation of an energy conservation
measure.
(2) Sources of energy-related cost savings shall include
only the following:
(i) Avoided current or planned capital expense.
(ii) Transfer of responsibility for operating and <
maintaining and equipment repair and replacement to the
energy savings company.
(iii) (II) Avoided renovation, renewal or repair <
costs as a result of replacing old and unreliable
equipment and systems or thermal improvements to the
building envelope.
"Energy savings SERVICES company." A commercial or nonprofit <
business providing QUALIFIED PROVIDER OF energy solutions, <
including designs and implementation of energy savings projects,
retrofitting, energy conservation, energy infrastructure
outsourcing, power generation and energy supply and risk
management.

- 1 "Operating costs." As follows:
- 2 (1) Reductions in expenses, including energy-related
- 3 cost savings, related to energy and water consuming equipment
- 4 <u>or the building envelope.</u>
- 5 (2) The term includes:
- 6 <u>(i) Operating and maintenance savings.</u>
- 7 <u>(ii) Capital funds budgeted for projects that, due</u>
- 8 <u>to the energy savings SERVICES company project, will not <--</u>
- 9 be necessary.

- 11 Section 2. Sections 3754(a) and 3755(c) of Title 62 are
- 12 amended to read:
- 13 § 3754. Contract provisions.
- 14 (a) General rule. -- A quaranteed energy savings contract may
- 15 provide that all payments, except obligations on termination of
- 16 the contract before its scheduled expiration, shall be made over
- 17 a period of time. Every guaranteed energy savings contract that
- 18 requires payments over a period of time shall provide that,
- 19 after the initial year of the contract, the savings in every
- 20 subsequent year are guaranteed to the extent necessary to make
- 21 payments under the contract during that year. A guaranteed
- 22 energy savings contract, IN ADDITION TO THE QUANTIFICATION AND <--
- 23 GUARANTEE OF ENERGY SAVINGS, shall expressly state, QUANTIFY AND <--
- 24 VALIDATE THE BUDGETARY SOURCES OF ALL ENERGY-RELATED COST
- 25 SAVINGS AND OPERATING COSTS UTILIZED TO SATISFY the financial
- 26 obligations that an energy savings company will require users to <--
- 27 <u>pay upon a declaration of savings AND PERFORMANCE DURING THE</u>
- 28 TERM OF THE AGREEMENT.

- 30 § 3755. Funding.

- 2 (c) Grants, subsidies or other payments.--Grants, subsidies
- 3 or other payments from the Commonwealth to a governmental unit
- 4 shall not be reduced as a result of energy <u>conservation measure</u>
- 5 <u>cost</u> savings obtained as a result of a guaranteed energy savings
- 6 contract during the life of the contract.
- 7 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
