AN ACT

Section 1506(c)(1) of Title 74 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 1506. Fund. 8 * * * 9 10 (c) Other deposits. -- The following shall be deposited into the fund annually: 11 [4.4%] 6.15% of the amount collected under Article 12 13 II of the Tax Reform Code. Revenues under this paragraph 14 shall be deposited into the fund by the 20th day of each 15 month for the preceding month. The amount deposited under 16 this paragraph is estimated to be equivalent to the money 17 available to the department from the following sources:

7	15% requirement set forth under paragraph (1)(i). The local
8	matching funds shall be increased annually by a minimum of 5%
