## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 2 3 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; 5 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 6 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 7 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 elections," in voting by qualified absentee electors, further 11 providing for applications for official absentee ballots. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 1302 of the act of June 3, 1937 16 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is 17 amended by adding a subsection to read: 18 Section 1302. Applications for Official Absentee Ballots. --\* 19 20 (1) If an electronic system under subsection (k) is 21 available by which a qualified elector may request permanent absentee voter status, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 22 include an option for a qualified elector who has received 23

- 1 permanent absentee voter status to electronically cancel the
- 2 <u>elector's permanent absentee voter status, provided the system</u>
- 3 <u>is able to capture a digitized or electronic signature of the</u>
- 4 <u>applicant.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
