15	(4) The Attorney General shall establish ongoing <
16	QUARTERLY communication with the Department of Aging in order <
17	to ensure that consumers who are at least 60 years of age
18	have access to information regarding the prevention of
19	potential patterns of financial exploitation. The Attorney
20	General shall coordinate with the Secretary of Aging to <
