5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	<u>§ 7388. Online training for firefighters.</u>
10	(a) General rule. Under section 2413 of the act of March 4, <
11	1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, the
12	Office of the State Fire Commissioner shall establish guidelines
13	for the use of money deposited into the Online Training Educator
14	and Training Reimbursement Account and dedicated for the
15	purposes of developing, delivering and sustaining training
16	programs for firefighters. The guidelines shall provide that the
17	money be used for online training for volunteer firefighters

1	and, notwithstanding the deposit for only volunteer firefighters
2	under section 2413(a)(2) of the Tax Reform Code of 1971, career_
3	firefighters and shall include, at a minimum, the following:
4	(A) DUTY TO ESTABLISH GUIDELINESTHE COMMISSIONER SHALL <
5	ESTABLISH GUIDELINES FOR DEVELOPING, DELIVERING AND SUSTAINING
6	TRAINING PROGRAMS FOR VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS AND CAREER
7	FIREFIGHTERS. THE GUIDELINES SHALL INCLUDE, AT A MINIMUM, THE
8	FOLLOWING:
9	(1) Participation in the training shall be on a
10	voluntary basis.
11	(2) The training shall be offered free of charge.
12	(3) The training shall be incorporated into the Train PA
13	system OR ANY OTHER SYSTEM APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER. <
14	(b) PrioritizationIn establishing online training
15	courses, the commissioner shall prioritize specific topics.
16	(c) Certificate of completionThe commissioner shall
17	provide a certificate of completion to an individual who
18	successfully completes an online training program.
19	(d) PublicationThe Office of the State Fire Commissioner
20	shall post a complete listing of the available online training
21	courses on the office's publicly accessible Internet website.
22	(E) FUNDINGTHE COMMISSIONER SHALL USE MONEY IN THE ONLINE <
23	TRAINING EDUCATOR AND TRAINING REIMBURSEMENT ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED
