## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 1 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 5 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 12 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 18 19 commissions shall be determined," in powers and duties in 20 general, providing for contact information. 21 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- 24 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 25 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a
- 26 section to read:

- 1 <u>Section 531. Contact Information.--Each department, board</u>
- 2 and commission must do all of the following:
- 3 (1) Establish a toll-free telephone number that is staffed
- 4 by an individual during regular business hours which may be used
- 5 to contact the department, board or commission.
- 6 (2) Post the telephone number established under paragraph
- 7 (1) in a clear and conspicuous manner on the department's
- 8 <u>Internet website</u>, board's Internet website or commission's
- 9 <u>Internet website.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
