4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 4524 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8	§ 4524. Windshield obstructions and wipers.

10	(e.1) Vehicle safety inspection
11	(1) A motor vehicle which is equipped with tinted
12	windows shall be tested as part of the motor vehicle safety
13	inspection and shall fail inspection if it violates
14	subsection (e).
15	(2) Failing to inform a purchaser of window tinting
16	services for a motor vehicle that an alteration or
17	modification will cause the motor vehicle to violate
18	subsection (e) shall constitute unfair methods of competition

1	and unfair or deceptive acts or practices within the meaning
2	of section 2(4) of the act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224,
3	No.387), known as the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer
4	Protection Law, and shall be subject to the enforcement
5	provisions, civil penalties and private rights of action
6	contained in that act.
7	* * *
8	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
