## AN ACT

19	individual in connection with the violation; or

2	vehicle at the time of the violation.
3	(b) Notification. The suspension under subsection (a) shall
4	occur immediately after the department receives a certified copy
5	of the charges filed against an individual to whom subsection
6	(a) applies from a law enforcement agency in this Commonwealth.
7	(c) Timing of suspension. The suspension of operating
8	privilege under this section shall occur regardless of whether
9	the individual has been found guilty or has entered a plea of
10	<del>guilty or nolo contendere.</del>
11	(d) Cooperation Each law enforcement agency in this
12	<u>Commonwealth shall cooperate in providing information to the</u>
13	department to carry out the provisions of this section.
14	(e) Rules and regulations. The department shall promulgate
15	rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of
