## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 29, 1803 (P.L.542, No.156), entitled
- "An act to establish a Board of Wardens for the port of
- Philadelphia, and for the regulation of pilots and pilotages,
- and for other purposes therein mentioned," providing for
- 5 licensed pilot and apprentice liability.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of March 29, 1803 (P.L.542, No.156),
- 9 entitled "An act to establish a Board of Wardens for the port of
- 10 Philadelphia, and for the regulation of pilots and pilotages,
- 11 and for other purposes therein mentioned," is amended by adding
- 12 a section to read:
- 13 Section 31.2. (a) The purpose of this section is to
- 14 <u>stimulate and preserve maritime commerce on the pilotage grounds</u>
- 15 of this Commonwealth by limiting and regulating the liability of
- 16 <u>certain pilots</u>, which commerce is essential to the economic
- 17 <u>viability of this Commonwealth's maritime commerce and serves</u>
- 18 the public interests.
- 19 (b) A licensed pilot or apprentice providing pilot services
- 20 shall not be liable for more than five thousand dollars for

- 1 damage or loss caused by the licensed pilot's or apprentice's
- 2 error, omission, fault or neglect in the performance of the
- 3 pilot services, except for the following:
- 4 (1) damage or loss that arises because of the willful
- 5 <u>misconduct or reckless disregard for safety by the licensed</u>
- 6 pilot or apprentice; or
- 7 (2) an act or omission relating to the ownership and
- 8 operation of a pilot boat unless the pilot boat is directly
- 9 <u>involved in pilot services other than the transportation of</u>
- 10 licensed pilots.
- 11 (c) This section does not exempt a vessel or its owner or
- 12 <u>operator from liability for damage or loss caused by the vessel</u>
- 13 to a person or property on the grounds that:
- 14 (1) the vessel was piloted by a licensed pilot or
- 15 <u>apprentice</u>; or
- 16 (2) the damage or loss was caused by the error, omission,
- 17 <u>fault or neglect of a licensed pilot or apprentice.</u>
- 18 (d) In a proceeding brought against a licensed pilot or
- 19 apprentice for an act or omission for which liability is limited
- 20 as provided by this section, and in which other claims are made
- 21 or anticipated with respect to the same act or omission, the
- 22 court shall dismiss the proceedings as to the licensed pilot or
- 23 apprentice to the extent the pleadings allege a liability of the
- 24 pilot that exceeds five thousand dollars.
- 25 (e) Liability under this section shall also be limited as
- 26 follows:
- 27 (1) A pilot or apprentice shall not be liable directly or as
- 28 a member of an organization of pilots for any claim that:
- 29 <u>(i) arises from an act or omission of another pilot,</u>
- 30 apprentice or organization of pilots; and

- 1 (ii) relates directly or indirectly to pilot services.
- 2 (2) An organization of pilots shall not be liable for
- 3 damages caused by a licensed pilot's or apprentice's error,
- 4 omission, fault or neglect in the performance of pilotage.
- 5 (f) For the sole purpose of occasions when this section is
- 6 applicable as a defense to liability by a licensed pilot or
- 7 apprentice, the licensed pilot or apprentice asserting the
- 8 <u>defense shall be considered to have been acting as the servant</u>
- 9 of the vessel, its owner and its operator.
- 10 (g) This section shall apply to all causes of action that
- 11 occur on or after the effective date of this section.
- (h) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 13 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless\_
- 14 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 15 "Apprentice." A person appointed as an apprentice pilot
- 16 <u>under 4 Pa. Code § 405.9 (relating to apprentices).</u>
- 17 "Pilot." A person licensed under 4 Pa. Code Ch. 405
- 18 (relating to pilots and pilotage) by the Navigation Commission
- 19 for the Delaware River and its Navigable Tributaries.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
