17	Section 1. The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), known <
18	as The Insurance Department Act of 1921, is amended by adding an-

1 SECTION 601-A. DEFINITIONS.

2 THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES WHEN USED IN THIS ARTICLE

14 IN THE EVENT OF DEATH OR DISMEMBERMENT BY ACCIDENT AND
15 BENEFITS FOR DISABILITY INCOME.

16 (2) ACCIDENT AND HEALTH OR SICKNESS. INSURANCE COVERAGE
17 FOR SICKNESS, BODILY INJURY OR ACCIDENTAL DEATH AND MAY
18 INCLUDE BENEFITS FOR DISABILITY INCOME.

PROPERTY. INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE DIRECT OR
 CONSEQUENTIAL LOSS OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY OF EVERY KIND.

(4) CASUALTY. INSURANCE COVERAGE AGAINST LEGAL
LIABILITY, INCLUDING THAT FOR DEATH, INJURY OR DISABILITY OR
DAMAGE TO REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY.

(5) VARIABLE LIFE AND VARIABLE ANNUITY PRODUCTS.
INSURANCE COVERAGE PROVIDED UNDER VARIABLE LIFE INSURANCE
CONTRACTS AND VARIABLE ANNUITIES.

25	(1) An applicant for a self-service storage agent	<
26	PRODUCER license shall file a written application in a form	<
27	prescribed by the department. The application shall specify	
28	all locations in this Commonwealth that the self-service	
29	storage agent PRODUCER may conduct business under the	<
30	license.	

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1	(2) A self-service storage agent PRODUCER is not <
2	required to have an individual licensee in each self-service
3	storage facility or place where insurance is transacted.
4	(3) The self-service storage agent PRODUCER shall notify <
5	the department within 30 days after commencing business under
6	the self-service storage agent's PRODUCER'S license at any <
7	additional locations in this Commonwealth or of those
8	locations in this Commonwealth that cease to do business
9	under the license.
10	(c) Sale of insuranceA self-service storage agent <
11	PRODUCER may offer or sell insurance only in connection with and <
12	incidental to the rental of space at a self-service storage
13	facility on a master, corporate, commercial, group or individual
14	policy basis and only with respect to personal property
15	insurance that provides PRIMARY coverage to occupants at the <
16	self-service storage facility where the insurance is transacted
17	for the loss of or damage to stored personal property that <
18	occurs at that facility OR WHILE THE PERSONAL PROPERTY IS IN <
19	TRANSIT DURING THE RENTAL AGREEMENT.
20	(d) RequirementsA self-service storage agent PRODUCER <
21	shall not offer or sell insurance under this section unless:
22	(1) The self-service storage agent PRODUCER makes <
23	readily available to the prospective occupant brochures or
24	other written materials that:
25	(i) Summarize the material terms of insurance
26	coverage offered to occupants, including the identity of
27	the insurer, price, benefits, DEDUCTIBLES, exclusions and <
28	conditions.
29	(ii) Disclose that the policies offered by the self-
30	<pre>service storage agent PRODUCER may provide a duplication <</pre>

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1	of coverage already provided by an occupant's homeowner's	
2	insurance policy, renter's insurance policy, vehicle	
3	insurance policy, watercraft insurance policy or other	
4	source of property insurance coverage. THE DISCLOSURE	<
5	SHALL BE PROMINENTLY DISPLAYED IN THE BROCHURE OR OTHER	
6	WRITTEN MATERIALS WITH AT LEAST 12-POINT BOLD TYPE.	
7	(III) STATE THAT THE INSURANCE PRESCRIBED IN THIS	
8	SECTION IS PRIMARY COVERAGE OVER ANY OTHER COVERAGE	
9	COVERING THE SAME LOSS.	
10	(iii) (IV) State that if insurance is required as a •	<
11	condition of rental, the requirement may be satisfied by	
12	the occupant purchasing the insurance prescribed in this	
13	section or by presenting evidence of other applicable	
14	insurance coverage.	
15	(V) STATE THAT THE PURCHASE OF THE INSURANCE	<
16	PRESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION IS NOT REQUIRED IN ORDER TO	
17	RENT STORAGE SPACE. THE STATEMENT SHALL BE PROMINENTLY	
18	DISPLAYED IN THE BROCHURE OR OTHER WRITTEN MATERIALS WITH	
19	AT LEAST 12-POINT BOLD TYPE.	
20	(iv) (VI) Describe the process for filing a claim.	<
21	(VII) INCLUDE CONTACT INFORMATION FOR FILING A	<

23	(2) All costs related to the insurance are stated in	
24	writing.	
25	(3) Evidence of coverage in a form approved by the	
26	insurer is provided to every occupant who purchases the	
27	coverage.	
28	(4) The insurance is provided by an insurer authorized	
29	to transact the applicable kinds of insurance in this	
30	Commonwealth or by a surplus lines insurer under Article V.	

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1	(e) Employee or agent AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE <
2	(1) An employee or agent AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE of a <
3	self-service storage agent PRODUCER may act on behalf of and <
4	under the supervision of the self-service storage agent <
5	PRODUCER in matters relating to the conduct of business under <
6	the license that is issued under this section.
7	(2) The conduct of an employee or agent AUTHORIZED <
8	REPRESENTATIVE of a self-service storage agent PRODUCER <
9	acting within the scope of employment or agency is deemed the
10	<pre>conduct of the self-service storage agent PRODUCER for <</pre>
11	purposes of this section.
12	(3) THE SELF-SERVICE STORAGE PRODUCER SHALL MAINTAIN A <
13	REGISTER, ON A FORM WHICH THE COMMISSIONER REQUIRES, OF EACH
14	EMPLOYEE OR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SELF-SERVICE
15	STORAGE PRODUCER WHO OFFERS THE INSURANCE PRESCRIBED IN THIS
16	SECTION ON BEHALF OF THE SELF-SERVICE STORAGE PRODUCER AND
17	SHALL, UPON REQUEST OF THE COMMISSIONER, SUBMIT THE REGISTER
18	FOR INSPECTION BY THE COMMISSIONER.
19	(f) TrainingEach self-service storage agent PRODUCER <
20	<pre>shall provide, OR CAUSE A LICENSED PRODUCER TO PROVIDE, a <</pre>
21	training program that gives employees and agents AUTHORIZED <
22	REPRESENTATIVES of the self-service storage agent PRODUCER basic <
23	instruction about the provisions of this section, including the <
24	<u>kinds of insurance coverage prescribed in this section.</u> , <
25	INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING:
26	(1) GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT HOMEOWNERS, RENTERS,
27	BUSINESS AND SIMILAR INSURANCE THAT AN OCCUPANT MAY HAVE THAT
28	MAY PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PROPERTY STORED AT A SELF-SERVICE
29	STORAGE FACILITY.
30	(2) INFORMATION ABOUT THE MATERIAL TERMS OF INSURANCE
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1	COVERAGE OFFERED TO OCCUPANTS, INCLUDING THE PRICE, BENEFITS,	_

4	(g) ProhibitionsA self-service storage agent PRODUCER may	<

6	(1) Offer or sell insurance except in connection with	
7	and incidental to the rental of space at a self-service	
8	storage facility.	
9	(2) Advertise, represent or otherwise portray itself or	
10	any of its employees or agents AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES as	<
11	licensed insurers or insurance producers.	
12	(H) ENFORCEMENT A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION SHALL	<
13	CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF THIS ACT AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE	
14	PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 691-A AND 692-A.	
15	(I) ExclusionsNothing in this section shall be	<
16	construed to prohibit:	
17	(1) An insurer from paying, and a self-service storage	
18	agent PRODUCER from receiving, a commission, service fee or	<
19	other valuable consideration dependent on the sale of	
20	insurance.	
21	(2) A self-service storage agent PRODUCER from paying,	<
22	and its employees or agent AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE from	<
23	receiving, production payments or incentive payments if the	
24	payments are not dependent on the sale of insurance.	
25	(i) Promotional materialsAn owner is not required to	<
26	be licensed under this section solely to display and make	
27	available to prospective occupants brochures and other	
28	promotional materials created by or on behalf of an authorized	
29	insurer or by a surplus lines insurer under this article. IF THE	<
30	OWNER AND ITS UNLICENSED EMPLOYEES AND AUTHORIZED	

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1	<u>REPRESENTATIVES DO NOT SOLICIT PROSPECTIVE OCCUPANTS TO PURCHASE</u>

3	(j) (K) Continuing educationA self-service storage agent <
4	PRODUCER is not subject to continuing education requirements. <
5	(k) (L) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following <
6	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
7	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
8	<u>"Occupant." A person or the person's sublessee, successor or <</u>
9	assign who is entitled to the use of a leased space or spaces at
10	a self service storage facility, to the exclusion of others.
11	"Owner." The owner or owner's managing agent of a self-
12	service storage facility.
13	<u>"Personal property." Movable property that is not affixed to</u>
14	land and includes:
15	(1) Goods, wares, merchandise, household items and
16	<u>furnishings.</u>
17	(2) Vehicles, motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers.
18	(3) Watercraft and motorized watercraft.
19	"OCCUPANT." AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE ACT OF DECEMBER <
20	20, 1982 (P.L.1404, NO.325), KNOWN AS THE SELF-SERVICE STORAGE
21	FACILITY ACT.
22	"OWNER." AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE SELF-SERVICE STORAGE
23	FACILITY ACT.
24	"PERSONAL PROPERTY." AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE SELF-
25	SERVICE STORAGE FACILITY ACT.
26	"Self-service storage agent PRODUCER." An owner or self- <
27	<pre>service storage facility operator who is licensed under this <</pre>
28	section.
29	<u>"Self-service storage facility." Real property that is used</u> <
30	for renting or leasing storage space in which occupants store
