12	(a.1) Additional offense definedThe Governor or a person
13	acting on behalf of the Governor is guilty of bribery, a felony
14	of the third degree, if he offers or promises to confer upon a
15	member of the General Assembly or a person within the member's
16	immediate family a specified appointed position in exchange for
17	the member's official vote on a matter before a house, committee
18	or subcommittee of the General Assembly.
