Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for the offense of aggravated assault. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2702(a)(2) and (b) of Title 18 of the 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and subsection 7 8 (c) is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 9 § 2702. Aggravated assault. 10 Offense defined. -- A person is guilty of aggravated 11 assault if he: 12 13 attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or recklessly causes serious bodily injury to any of the 14 15 officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in 16 subsection (c) [or to an employee of an agency, company or other entity engaged in public transportation], while in the 17
