## A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for courts to be open and suits against the Commonwealth.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That Section 11 of Article I be amended to read:
9	§ 11. Courts to be open; suits against the Commonwealth.
10	(a) All courts shall be open; and every man for an injury
11	done him in his lands, goods, person or reputation shall have
12	remedy by due course of law, and right and justice administered
13	without sale, denial or delay. Suits may be brought against the
14	Commonwealth in such manner, in such courts and in such cases as
15	the Legislature may by law direct.
16	(b) An individual for whom a statutory limitations period
17	has already expired, or whose claim would otherwise be barred or

1 limited by a statutory cap on damages, sovereign immunity or by governmental or official immunity, shall have a period of two 2 years, without bar or limitation by such caps or immunities, 3 from the time that this subsection becomes effective to commence 4 an action arising from childhood sexual abuse, in such cases as 5 provided by law at the time that this subsection becomes 6 7 effective. 8 Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed 9 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution: 10 Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of (1)the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 11 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising 12 13 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution

14 of Pennsylvania.

15 (2) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of 16 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 17 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution 18 19 of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this 20 21 Commonwealth at the first general election which meets the 22 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution 23 of Pennsylvania.
