## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, in riot, disorderly conduct and
- related offenses, providing for transfer and sale of animals.
- 4 This act may be referred to as Victoria's Law.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Chapter 55 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:
- 9 <u>SUBCHAPTER C</u>
- 10 TRANSFER AND SALE OF ANIMALS

- 12 <u>5571. Definitions.</u>
- 13 <u>5572</u>. Advertising information.
- 14 <u>5573</u>. <u>Sales by pet shops</u>.
- 15 <u>5574</u>. <u>Enforcement</u>.
- 16 § 5571. Definitions.
- 17 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter

- 1 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 2 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 3 "Animal care facility." An animal control center or animal
- 4 shelter, maintained by or under contract with a State, county or
- 5 municipality, the mission or practice of which is to protect the
- 6 welfare of animals and the placement of animals in permanent
- 7 <u>homes or animal rescue organizations.</u>
- 8 "Animal rescue organization." As follows:
- 9 (1) A not-for-profit organization that has tax-exempt
- 10 <u>status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code</u>
- of 1986 (Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3)), the
- 12 <u>primary mission or practice of which is the rescue of animals</u>
- and the placement of those animals in permanent homes.
- 14 (2) The term does not include the following:
- 15 <u>(i) An entity that is a breeder or broker.</u>
- 16 <u>(ii) An entity that is affiliated with or housed on</u>
- the premises of a breeder or broker.
- 18 (iii) An entity that obtains dogs from a breeder or
- 19 broker in exchange for payment or compensation or resells
- 20 dogs obtained from a breeder or broker and provides
- 21 payment or compensation to the breeder or broker.
- 22 "Breeder." A person that maintains dogs, cats or rabbits for
- 23 the purpose of breeding and selling their offspring.
- 24 "Broker." A person that transfers dogs, cats or rabbits from
- 25 <u>a breeder for resale by another person.</u>
- 26 "Cat." As defined in section 102 of the Dog Law.
- 27 "Dog." As defined in section 102 of the Dog Law.
- 28 "Dog Law." The act of December 7, 1982 (P.L.784, No.225),
- 29 known as the Dog Law.
- 30 <u>"Offer for sale." To sell, offer for sale or adoption,</u>

- 1 barter, auction, give away or otherwise transfer a dog, cat or
- 2 rabbit.
- 3 "Pet shop." A person or facility that offers for sale on a
- 4 retail basis animals to be kept as household pets.
- 5 "Police officer." As defined in section 102 of the Dog Law.
- 6 "Rabbit." A domesticated or pet rabbit. The term does not
- 7 <u>include a rabbit intended for human consumption.</u>
- 8 "State dog warden." As defined in section 102 of the Dog
- 9 <u>Law.</u>
- 10 § 5572. Advertising information.
- 11 (a) Requirement. -- An individual required to possess a
- 12 Federal, State or local license to breed or broker dogs shall
- 13 prominently include that individual's name or business name as
- 14 registered with the licensing agency and each applicable
- 15 Federal, State or local license number in the text of an
- 16 advertisement offer for the sale of a dog through a newspaper,
- 17 posting, the mail, an Internet website or another form of media.
- 18 (b) Penalty. -- An individual who violates subsection (a)
- 19 shall be subject to a civil penalty of \$100 for each
- 20 advertisement offer.
- 21 § 5573. Sales by pet shops.
- 22 (a) Offense defined. -- No pet shop may offer for sale a doq,
- 23 cat or rabbit.
- (b) Construction. -- Subsection (a) shall not be construed to
- 25 prohibit a pet shop from providing space to an animal care
- 26 facility or animal rescue organization if:
- 27 (1) the animal care facility or animal rescue
- 28 organization offers dogs, cats or rabbits for adoption in
- accordance with the adoption procedures of section 902-A of
- 30 the Dog Law;

- 1 (2) the pet shop does not have an ownership interest in
- 2 the animals offered; and
- 3 (3) the pet shop does not receive a fee for providing
- 4 space for the adoption of an animal.
- 5 (c) Grading. -- A violation of this section is a summary
- 6 offense punishable by a fine of not less than \$500 per animal
- 7 offered for sale in violation of this section.
- 8 § 5574. Enforcement.
- 9 A police officer or State dog warden, in addition to any
- 10 other person otherwise authorized by law, may enforce the
- 11 provisions of this subchapter.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
