1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	Amending the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), entitled "An act providing for the licensing of eligible organizations to conduct games of chance, for the licensing of persons to distribute games of chance, for the registration of manufacturers of games of chance, and for suspensions and revocations of licenses and permits; requiring records; providing for local referendum by electorate; and prescribing penalties," in games of chance, providing for games of chance operations during disaster emergency.
11	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12	hereby enacts as follows:
13	Section 1. The act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156),
14	known as the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act, is amended
15	by adding a section to read:
16	Section 309. Games of chance operations during disaster
17	emergency.
18	(a) General rule. Notwithstanding the provisions of section <
19	307 (b.2), during a disaster emergency, a licensed eligible
20	organization may:

1	(1) conduct games of chance through a publicly
2	accessible Internet website, social media platform or mobile
3	application; and
4	(2) accept electronic payment via credit card, debit
5	card, mobile electronic payment application or other
6	electronic payment methods for playing games of chance under
7	paragraph (1). The licensed eligible organization shall
8	verify that the purchaser using an electronic payment method
9	is:
10	(i) 18 years of age or older; and
11	(ii) a resident of this Commonwealth.
12	(b) Prize disbursement. A winner of a game of chance
13	conducted under subsection (a) must claim the prize at the
14	licensed eligible organization's operating site or other
15	authorized premises. Prize winnings may not be distributed via
16	United States mail, electronically or via any other messaging
17	service. Prior to disbursing a prize, a licensed eligible
18	organization must verify in person the winner's age and
19	residency as provided under subsection (a) (2).
20	(c) Definition. As used in this section, the term "disaster_
21	emergency" means the proclamation of disaster emergency issued
22	by the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644
23	(March 21, 2020), and any renewal of the state of disaster
24	emergency.
25	(A) OPERATIONS NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION <-
26	307(B.2), DURING THE COVID-19 DISASTER EMERGENCY OR UNTIL MAY 1,
27	2022, WHICHEVER IS LATER, A LICENSED ELIGIBLE ORGANIZATION MAY
28	CONDUCT AND REVEAL THE WINNER OF RAFFLES AND DRAWINGS VIA AN
29	INTERNET-BASED CONFERENCING SOFTWARE APPLICATION IN A MANNER
30	OTHERWISE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS CHAPTER.

1	(B) RAFFLES AND DRAWINGS THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY TO A
2	RAFFLE OR DRAWING AUTHORIZED UNDER SUBSECTION (A):
3	(1) A LICENSED ELIGIBLE ORGANIZATION MAY ACCEPT PAYMENT
4	VIA A MOBILE PAYMENT SERVICE FOR THE CONDUCT OR OPERATION OF
5	THE RAFFLE OR DRAWING IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (C). AN
6	ELIGIBLE ORGANIZATION MAY NOT ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS FOR THE
7	CONDUCT OR OPERATION OF THE RAFFLE OR DRAWING.
8	(2) AN ELIGIBLE ORGANIZATION MAY ONLY USE AN INTERNET-
9	BASED CONFERENCING SOFTWARE APPLICATION IN THE CONDUCT OF THE
10	RAFFLE OR DRAWING LIMITED TO THE REVEAL OF THE WINNER OF THE
11	RAFFLE OR DRAWING.
12	(3) THE REVEAL OF THE WINNER OF THE RAFFLE OR DRAWING
13	MAY NOT USE OR DISPLAY ANIMATION IN IDENTIFYING THE WINNER.
14	(4) THE REVEAL OF THE WINNER OF THE RAFFLE OR DRAWING
15	MAY NOT USE OR DISPLAY MOVING OR STILL IMAGES IN IDENTIFYING
16	THE WINNER.
17	(5) THE REVEAL OF THE WINNER OF THE RAFFLE OR DRAWING
18	MAY NOT USE, MAKE OR DISPLAY A GRAPHIC PRESENTATION IN
19	IDENTIFYING THE WINNER.
20	(6) THE REVEAL OF THE WINNER OF THE RAFFLE OR DRAWING
21	MAY NOT USE OR BE COMPLETED WITH THE AID OF A SLOT MACHINE,
22	HYBRID SLOT MACHINE OR SKILL SLOT MACHINE AS DEFINED IN 4
23	PA.C.S. § 1103 (RELATING TO DEFINITIONS).
24	(7) THE REVEAL OF THE WINNER OF THE RAFFLE OR DRAWING
25	MAY NOT USE OR BE COMPLETED WITH THE AID OF A VIDEO GAMING
26	TERMINAL AS DEFINED IN 4 PA.C.S. § 3102 (RELATING TO
27	DEFINITIONS).
28	(8) THE REVEAL OF THE WINNER OF THE RAFFLE OR DRAWING
29	MAY NOT USE OR BE COMPLETED WITH THE AID OF AN ELECTRONIC

- 3 (C) VERIFICATION REQUIREMENTS. -- IN ORDER TO USE A MOBILE
- 4 PAYMENT SERVICE UNDER SUBSECTION (B) (1) FOR THE CONDUCT OR
- 5 OPERATION OF THE RAFFLE OR DRAWING, A LICENSED ELIGIBLE
- 6 ORGANIZATION SHALL TAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS:
- 7 (1) EMPLOY A MECHANISM TO DETECT THE PHYSICAL LOCATION
- 8 OF A PARTICIPANT WHO BUYS A TICKET FOR THE RAFFLE OR DRAWING
- 9 AND BLOCK AN INDIVIDUAL LOCATED OUTSIDE OF THIS COMMONWEALTH
- 10 FROM PARTICIPATING IN A RAFFLE OR DRAWING. THE ELIGIBLE
- ORGANIZATION MAY NOT ACCEPT PAYMENT FROM AN INDIVIDUAL
- 12 LOCATED OUTSIDE OF THIS COMMONWEALTH.
- 13 (2) EMPLOY A MECHANISM TO VERIFY A PARTICIPANT'S
- 14 IDENTITY AND RECORD THE DOCUMENT NUMBER OF THE PARTICIPANT'S
- GOVERNMENT-ISSUED CREDENTIAL OR EMPLOY ANY OTHER METHODOLOGY
- 16 FOR REMOTE, MULTISOURCED IDENTITY AUTHENTICATION, INCLUDING
- 17 THE USE OF A THIRD-PARTY OR GOVERNMENT DATABASE.
- 18 (3) EMPLOY A MECHANISM TO VERIFY THAT THE PURCHASER IS
- 19 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AND BLOCK AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER 18
- 20 YEARS OF AGE FROM PARTICIPATING IN THE RAFFLE OR DRAWING. THE
- 21 ELIGIBLE ORGANIZATION MAY NOT ACCEPT PAYMENT FROM AN
- 22 INDIVIDUAL UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE.
- 23 (4) REOUIRE A PARTICIPANT TO AFFIRM THAT THE INFORMATION
- 24 PROVIDED BY THE PARTICIPANT UNDER THIS SECTION IS ACCURATE.
- 25 (5) RECORD A PARTICIPANT'S ACKNOWLEDGMENT THAT THE
- 26 INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE PARTICIPANT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
- 27 IS ACCURATE.
- 28 (D) EXPIRATION.--THE AUTHORITY GRANTED UNDER THIS SECTION
- 29 SHALL AUTOMATICALLY EXPIRE UPON EXPIRATION OR TERMINATION OF THE
- 30 COVID-19 DISASTER EMERGENCY BY EXECUTIVE ORDER, PROCLAMATION OR

- 1 OPERATION OF LAW OR MAY 1, 2022, WHICHEVER IS LATER.
- 2 (E) DEFINITIONS.--AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING
- 3 WORDS AND PHRASES SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS
- 4 SUBSECTION UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 5 "COVID-19 DISASTER EMERGENCY." THE PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER
- 6 EMERGENCY ISSUED BY THE GOVERNOR ON MARCH 6, 2020, PUBLISHED AT
- 7 50 PA.B. 1644 (MARCH 21, 2020), ANY RENEWAL OF THE PROCLAMATION
- 8 OF DISASTER EMERGENCY OR ANY OTHER PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER
- 9 EMERGENCY RELATED TO THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS, KNOWN AS COVID-19,
- 10 ISSUED BY THE GOVERNOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH 35 PA.C.S. § 7301(C)
- 11 (RELATING TO GENERAL AUTHORITY OF GOVERNOR).
- 12 "DRAWING." A 50/50 DRAWING, DAILY DRAWING OR WEEKLY DRAWING.
- 13 "INTERNET-BASED CONFERENCING SOFTWARE APPLICATION." ANY OF
- 14 THE FOLLOWING:
- 15 (1) A SOFTWARE APPLICATION THAT ALLOWS FOR THE
- 16 TRANSMISSION OF AUDIO AND VISUAL COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN USERS
- 17 OVER THE INTERNET, INCLUDING ZOOM, MICROSOFT TEAMS, SKYPE OR
- AN EQUIVALENT APPLICATION.
- 19 (2) A SOCIAL NETWORKING APPLICATION THAT ALLOWS FOR THE
- TRANSMISSION OF AUDIO AND VISUAL COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN USERS
- 21 OVER THE INTERNET, INCLUDING FACEBOOK LIVE OR PERISCOPE.
- 22 "MOBILE PAYMENT SERVICE." A SERVICE IN WHICH A MONEY PAYMENT
- 23 IS MADE ELECTRONICALLY THROUGH A MONEY TRANSFER SERVICE,
- 24 INCLUDING VENMO, PAYPAL, CASH APP OR AN EQUIVALENT MONEY
- 25 TRANSFER SERVICE.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
