AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, No.69), entitled, as 1 amended, "An act relating to the practice of professional nursing; providing for the licensing of nurses and for the 3 revocation and suspension of such licenses, subject to appeal, and for their reinstatement; providing for the renewal of such licenses; regulating nursing in general; 5 6 prescribing penalties and repealing certain laws," providing 7 for the definition of "certified registered nurse anesthetist"; further providing for registered nurse, 9 clinical nurse specialist, use of title "C.N.S." and credentials and fraud; and providing for certified registered 10 11 nurse anesthetist and qualifications. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, No.69), known as The Professional Nursing Law, is amended by 16 17 adding a clause to read: 18 Section 2. Definitions .-- When used in this act, the 19 following words and phrases shall have the following meanings 20 unless the context provides otherwise: * * * 21
- 22 (16) "Certified registered nurse anesthetist" means a

- 1 registered nurse licensed in this Commonwealth who is certified
- 2 by the State Board of Nursing as a certified registered nurse
- 3 anesthetist.
- 4 Section 2. Section 3 of the act is amended to read:
- 5 Section 3. Registered Nurse, Clinical Nurse Specialist,
- 6 <u>Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist</u>, Use of Title and
- 7 Abbreviation ["R.N." or] <u>"R.N.,"</u> "C.N.S." <u>or "C.R.N.A."</u>;
- 8 Credentials; Fraud.--(a) Any person who holds a license to
- 9 practice professional nursing in this Commonwealth, or who is
- 10 maintained on inactive status in accordance with section 11 of
- 11 this act, shall have the right to use the titles "nurse" and
- 12 "registered nurse" and the abbreviation "R.N." No other person
- 13 shall engage in the practice of professional nursing or use the
- 14 titles "nurse" or "registered nurse" or the abbreviation "R.N."
- 15 to indicate that the person using the same is a registered
- 16 nurse, except that the title "nurse" also may be used by a
- 17 person licensed under the provisions of the act of March 2, 1956
- 18 (1955 P.L.1211, No.376), known as the "Practical Nurse Law." No
- 19 person shall sell or fraudulently obtain or fraudulently furnish
- 20 any nursing diploma, license, record, or registration or aid or
- 21 abet therein.
- 22 (b) An individual who holds a license to practice
- 23 professional nursing in this Commonwealth who meets the
- 24 requirements under sections 6.2 and 8.5 of this act to be a
- 25 clinical nurse specialist shall have the right to use the title
- 26 "clinical nurse specialist" and the abbreviation "C.N.S." No
- 27 other person shall have that right.
- 28 (b.1) An individual who holds a license to practice
- 29 professional nursing in this Commonwealth who meets the
- 30 requirements under section 8.8 of this act to be a certified

- 1 registered nurse anesthetist shall have the right to use the
- 2 title "certified registered nurse anesthetist" and the
- 3 <u>abbreviation "C.R.N.A." No other person shall have that right.</u>
- 4 (c) Notwithstanding subsection (a), this section shall not
- 5 prohibit the use by a person of a descriptive title for nurse
- 6 assistive personnel. For the purposes of this subsection, the
- 7 term "nurse assistive personnel" shall mean an individual
- 8 providing health care services under the supervision of a
- 9 professional or practical nurse.
- 10 (d) The board may issue a certification to a registered
- 11 <u>nurse anesthetist who has completed a course of study considered</u>
- 12 by the board to be equivalent to that required in this
- 13 Commonwealth under sections 6.2 and 8.8 of this act at the time
- 14 <u>such course was completed</u>, or who is licensed or certified by
- 15 <u>another state</u>, territory or possession of the United States or a
- 16 foreign country as deemed equivalent to Pennsylvania's
- 17 certification requirements, and who has met all the
- 18 requirements, including character, under this act.
- 19 Section 3. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 20 Section 8.8. Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist;
- 21 Qualifications. -- (a) The board may certify a licensed
- 22 registered nurse as a certified registered nurse anesthetist if
- 23 the nurse satisfies the requirements established by this act.
- 24 Certification of a certified registered nurse anesthetist by the
- 25 board shall expire on the same date as the license of that nurse
- 26 expires. Beginning on the effective date of this section, a
- 27 <u>nurse shall not qualify for initial certification by the board</u>
- 28 unless the nurse holds a master's degree, doctoral degree or
- 29 <u>post-master's certificate from an accredited educational program</u>
- 30 in nurse anesthesia that has been approved by the board and that

- 1 prepares graduates to practice as a certified registered nurse
- 2 anesthetist and:
- 3 (1) holds current national certification as a certified
- 4 <u>registered nurse anesthetist from a board-recognized national</u>
- 5 <u>certification organization which required passing of a national</u>
- 6 <u>certifying examination in nurse anesthesia; and</u>
- 7 (2) meets all other board requirements to practice as a
- 8 <u>certified registered nurse anesthetist.</u>
- 9 (b) A registered nurse who does not have a graduate degree
- 10 <u>as required under subsection (a) shall be qualified for</u>
- 11 <u>certification as a certified registered nurse anesthetist if</u>
- 12 that nurse:
- 13 (1) meets the educational requirements for certified
- 14 registered nurse anesthetists that were in effect in this
- 15 Commonwealth at the time the nurse completed a nurse anesthesia
- 16 educational program; and
- 17 (2) submits evidence of recertification as a certified
- 18 registered nurse anesthetist from a board-recognized national
- 19 certification organization which required passing of a national
- 20 certifying examination in nurse anesthesia.
- 21 (c) As a condition of biennial certificate renewal by the
- 22 board, a certified registered nurse anesthetist shall:
- 23 (1) Verify that the nurse holds current recertification from
- 24 a board-recognized national certification organization which
- 25 required passing of a national certifying examination in nurse
- 26 anesthesia.
- 27 (2) Submit a renewal application to the board.
- 28 (3) Pay a renewal fee as set by the board.
- 29 (4) In the two years prior to certification renewal,
- 30 complete at least thirty (30) hours of continuing education

- 1 approved by the board, as required by section 12.1 of this act.
- 2 (d) For certification under this act, a licensed registered
- 3 nurse shall file a board-prepared application with the board and
- 4 pay a fee as established by the board by regulation.
- 5 (e) A certified registered nurse anesthetist practicing in
- 6 this Commonwealth shall maintain a level of professional
- 7 <u>liability coverage as required for a nonparticipating health</u>
- 8 care provider under the act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13),
- 9 known as the "Medical Care Availability and Reduction of Error
- 10 (Mcare) Act," and shall not be eligible to participate in the
- 11 Medical Care Availability and Reduction of Error (Mcare) Fund.
- 12 Section 4. The State Board of Nursing shall promulgate
- 13 regulations to implement the amendment or addition of sections
- 14 2(16), 3 and 8.8 of the act within 18 months of the effective
- 15 date of this section.
- 16 Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
