## AN ACT

- 1 Establishing the Donated Dental Services Program; imposing
- duties on the Department of Health; providing for program
  - administration and for contract requirements; and making an
- 4 appropriation.

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- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Short title.
- 8 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Donated
- 9 Dental Services Act.
- 10 Section 2. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 "Department." The Department of Health of the Commonwealth.
- 15 "Program." The Donated Dental Services Program established
- 16 in section 3.
- 17 Section 3. Establishment of program.
- 18 The Donated Dental Services Program is established.

- 1 Section 4. Maintenance of program.
- 2 The department, in consultation with the Dental Lifeline
- 3 Network or its designee, shall maintain the program through
- 4 which volunteer dentists provide comprehensive dental care for
- 5 needy, disabled, aged and medically compromised individuals who
- 6 cannot afford necessary treatment but are ineligible for public
- 7 assistance. Eliqible individuals may be treated by the volunteer
- 8 dentists in their private offices or other appropriate
- 9 locations. Eligible individuals may not be required to pay a fee
- 10 or cost.
- 11 Section 5. Program administration.
- 12 To administer the program, the department shall contract with
- 13 the Dental Lifeline Network or its designee who must be
- 14 experienced in providing similar services or programs.
- 15 Section 6. Contract requirements.
- 16 The contract shall specify the responsibilities of the
- 17 administering organization that may include:
- 18 (1) The maintenance of a network of volunteer dentists,
- including dental specialists, volunteer dental laboratories
- and other appropriate volunteer professionals, to donate
- 21 dental services to eligible individuals.
- 22 (2) The maintenance of a system to refer eligible
- 23 individuals to appropriate volunteers.
- 24 (3) The continuance and implementation of a public
- awareness campaign to educate eligible individuals about the
- 26 availability of the program.
- 27 (4) Providing appropriate administrative and technical
- 28 support to the program.
- 29 (5) Submitting an annual report to the department that:
- 30 (i) Accounts for program funds.

- 1 (ii) Reports the number of individuals served by the
- 2 program and the number of dentists and dental
- 3 laboratories participating as providers in the program.
- 4 (iii) Other information required by the department.
- 5 (6) Performing, as required by the department, another
- 6 duty relating to the program.
- 7 Section 19. Appropriation.
- 8 The sum of \$150,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary,
- 9 is appropriated to the department for the fiscal year July 1,
- 10 2013, to June 30, 2014, to carry out the provisions of this act.
- 11 Section 20. Effective date.
- 12 This act shall take effect immediately.
