REFERRED TO URBAN AFFAIRS AND HOUSING, FEBRUARY 15, 2017

AN ACT

Amending the act of December 3, 1959 (P.L.1688, No.621), 1 entitled, as amended, "An act to promote the health, safety 2 and welfare of the people of the Commonwealth by broadening 3 the market for housing for persons and families of low and 4 moderate income and alleviating shortages thereof, and by 5 assisting in the provision of housing for elderly persons 6 7 through the creation of the Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency as a public corporation and government 8 instrumentality; providing for the organization, membership 9 10 and administration of the agency, prescribing its general powers and duties and the manner in which its funds are kept 11 and audited, empowering the agency to make housing loans to 12 qualified mortgagors upon the security of insured and 13 uninsured mortgages, defining qualified mortgagors and 14 providing for priorities among tenants in certain instances, 15 prescribing interest rates and other terms of housing loans, 16 permitting the agency to acquire real or personal property, 17 permitting the agency to make agreements with financial 18 institutions and Federal agencies, providing for the purchase 19 20 by persons of low and moderate income of housing units, and approving the sale of housing units, permitting the agency to 21 sell housing loans, providing for the promulgation of 22 23 regulations and forms by the agency, prescribing penalties for furnishing false information, empowering the agency to 24 borrow money upon its own credit by the issuance and sale of 25 bonds and notes and by giving security therefor, permitting 26 the refunding, redemption and purchase of such obligations by 27 the agency, prescribing remedies of holders of such bonds and 28 29 notes, exempting bonds and notes of the agency, the income 30 therefrom, and the income and revenues of the agency from 31 taxation, except transfer, death and gift taxes; making such bonds and notes legal investments for certain purposes; and 32 indicating how the act shall become effective," in the 33 agency, further providing for agency membership; and making 34

1 an editorial change.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 3 hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 202 of the act of December 3, 1959
(P.L.1688, No.621), known as the Housing Finance Agency Law, is
amended to read:

7 Section 202. Agency Membership. -- The members of the agency shall be the Secretary of Community [Affairs] and Economic_ 8 9 Development, the State Treasurer, [the Secretary of Commerce 10 and] the Secretary of Banking[,] and Securities, the Insurance 11 Commissioner and the respective successors in office of each of 12 them, one member appointed by the Majority Leader of the Senate, 13 one member appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate, one 14 member appointed by the Majority Leader of the House of 15 Representatives, one member appointed by the Minority Leader of 16 the House of Representatives and six additional members whom the 17 Governor shall appoint. One of the members of the agency appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the 18 19 Senate shall be a representative of a community-based nonprofit 20 group which assists low-income and moderate-income individuals in housing matters. Annually at the first meeting held during 21 22 the calendar year, the members shall elect one of the members to 23 serve as chairperson. The members initially appointed shall 24 serve for terms of one, two, three, four, five and six years, 25 respectively, the particular term of each to be designated by 26 the Governor at the time of appointment. The terms of all their 27 successors shall be six years each, except that any person 28 appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve only for the unexpired 29 term. Every member's term shall extend until his successor is 30 appointed and qualified. Any appointment made by the Governor of

a member of the agency made hereafter shall be subject to the 1 2 advice and consent of a majority of all the members of the 3 Senate. Any appointed member of the agency shall be eligible for reappointment. The members of the agency shall not receive 4 compensation for their services as members, but shall receive 5 reimbursement for all necessary expenses incurred in connection 6 7 with the performance of their duties as members. A member who 8 fails to attend meetings for three consecutive months shall forfeit his seat unless the chairperson of the agency, upon 9 10 written request from the member, finds that the member should be 11 excused from a meeting because of illness or the death of an 12 immediate family member. Members appointed by the Majority 13 Leader of the Senate, the Minority Leader of the Senate, the 14 Majority Leader of the House of Representatives and the Minority 15 Leader of the House of Representatives shall not be, themselves, 16 current members of the General Assembly and shall serve at the 17 pleasure of the appointing authority.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
