AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in certification of teachers, further 5 providing for locally issued temporary certification for 6 7 substitute teachers. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1215 of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 12 amended to read: 13 Section 1215. Locally Issued Temporary Certification for 14 Substitute Teachers.--(a) A temporary substitute teacher certificate may be issued by a public school entity to an 15 16 individual who:
- 17 <u>(1)</u> presents a letter from a college or university verifying
- 18 that the individual has completed an approved teacher
- 19 preparation program, has successfully completed the
- 20 certification testing requirements and has completed all

- 1 requirements for the awarding of a bachelor's degree on a date
- 2 certain[.];
- 3 (2) presents a letter from an accredited college or
- 4 <u>university verifying that the individual has completed at least</u>
- 5 sixty (60) credit hours; or
- 6 (3) presents evidence that the individual has a substitute
- 7 <u>teacher certificate issued by another state.</u>
- 8 (b) The temporary substitute teacher certificate shall only
- 9 be used for day-to-day assignments and shall expire upon the
- 10 termination of any summer school conducted in the summer which
- 11 follows the date of issuance or upon the receipt of
- 12 Instructional I certification by the individual.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
