Amending the act of September 30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), entitled "An act establishing salaries and compensation of 2 certain public officials including justices and judges of 3 Statewide courts, judges of courts of common pleas, judges of the Philadelphia Municipal Court, judges of the Philadelphia Traffic Court, district justices and the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor 6 7 General, the Attorney General and certain other State 8 officers and the salary and certain expenses of the members 9 10 of the General Assembly; and repealing certain inconsistent acts," further providing for members of the General Assembly. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 4(d) and (d.1) of the act of September 14 15 30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), known as the Public Official Compensation Law, amended October 16, 2020 (P.L.706, No.79), are 16 amended to read: 17 18 Section 4. Members of the General Assembly. * * * 19 20 Subsequent annual cost-of-living adjustment for 21 members.--22 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), for the 121 month period beginning December 1, 1997, through November 30,

2 [1998, and for each like 12-month period thereafter] 2021,

3 the salary of the members of the General Assembly shall be

4 increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment calculated

5 by applying the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index

for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New

Jersey, Delaware and Maryland area, for the most recent 12-

month period for which figures have been officially reported

9 by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor

Statistics immediately prior to the date the adjustment is

11 due to take effect, to the then current salary amounts. The

12 percentage increase and the new salary amounts shall be

determined jointly by the Chief Clerk of the Senate and the

Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives prior to the

annual effective date of the adjustment and shall be

published by them in the Pennsylvania Bulletin within ten

days of the date such determination is made.

prior to December 1, 2020.

(2) The salary of the members of the General Assembly may not be increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment under paragraph (1) for the period beginning December 1, 2020, through November 30, 2021. Notice of the provisions of this subsection shall be transmitted to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin

(3) Subject to subsection (c), for the 12-month period beginning December 1, 2025, through November 30, 2026, and for each like 12-month period thereafter, the salary of each legislator shall be increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment calculated by applying the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for

 - (2) The additional compensation of the officers and leaders of the General Assembly may not be increased by an annual cost-of-living adjustment under paragraph (1) for the period beginning December 1, 2020, through November 30, 2021. Notice of the provisions of this subsection shall be transmitted to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin prior to December 1, 2020.
- (3) Subject to subsection (c), for the 12-month period 12 beginning December 1, 2025, through November 30, 2026, and 13 14 for each like 12-month period thereafter, the additional 15 compensation of each legislator who is an officer and leader of the General Assembly shall be increased by an annual cost-16 17 of-living adjustment calculated by applying the percentage 18 change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers 19 (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware and 20 Maryland area, for the most recent 12-month period for which 21 figures have been officially reported by the United States 22 Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, immediately 23 prior to the date the adjustment is due to take effect, to 24 the then current compensation. The percentage increase and 25 the new compensation amounts shall be determined jointly by 26 the Chief Clerk of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the 27 House of Representatives prior to the annual effective date of the adjustment and shall be transmitted to the Legislative 28 29 Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin within 20 days immediately prior to each cost-of-living 30
