AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in reimbursements by Commonwealth and between school districts, further providing for payments on 5 6 account of pupils enrolled in career and technical 7 curriculums. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. Section 2502.8(b) of the act of March 10, 1949
- 12 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
- 13 amended by adding a clause to read:
- 14 Section 2502.8. Payments on Account of Pupils Enrolled in
- Career and Technical Curriculums. --* * * 15
- For the 1981-1982 school year through the 1984-1985 16 (b)
- 17 school year, each school district so entitled shall be paid, in
- 18 addition to any other subsidy to which it is entitled, an amount
- on account of resident pupils enrolled in career and technical 19
- 20 curriculums; for the 1985-1986 school year through the 1999-2000

- 1 school year, each school district and area career and technical
- 2 school shall be paid an amount on account of students enrolled
- 3 in career and technical curriculums; for the 2000-2001 school
- 4 year and each school year thereafter, each school district, area
- 5 career and technical school and charter school shall be paid an
- 6 amount on account of students enrolled in career and technical
- 7 curriculums, determined as follows:
- 8 * * *
- 9 (6) The data used for the calculations made in this section
- 10 shall be fixed as of the first day of June preceding the school
- 11 year in which the allocation occurs. Data fixed on the first day
- 12 of June shall be revised by the Department of Education if it is
- 13 subsequently found to be incorrect.

- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
