AN ACT

Amending the act of April 16, 1992 (P.L.155, No.28), entitled 1 "An act providing for the certification and recertification 2 of assessors; establishing eligibility and training 3 requirements; defining the powers and duties of the State Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers relating to 5 training, certification and recertification of assessors; and authorizing the board to establish fees," repealing 7 provisions relating to nonapplicability; and providing for 8 assessors in counties of the first class. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 11 of the act of April 16, 1992 (P.L.155, 13 No.28), known as the Assessors Certification Act, is repealed: 14 [Section 11. Nonapplicability. 15 This act shall not apply to counties of the first class. 16 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read: 17 Section 11.1. Assessors in counties of the first class. 18 An assessor who is employed by a county of the first class on 19 the effective date of this section shall have three years from the effective date of this section to become certified under 20

1 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
