AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act Providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 7 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 12 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; providing for the regulation of pari-mutuel 17 thoroughbred horse racing and harness horse racing 18 19 activities, imposing certain taxes and providing for the 20 disposition of funds from pari-mutuel tickets; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 21 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of 22 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 23 determined," in powers and duties of the Department of Labor 24 25 and Industry, its departmental administrative and advisory boards and departmental administrative officers, providing 26 for job creation; and making inconsistent repeals of certain 27 provisions of the Public School Code of 1949, the Human 28 Services Code, the Pennsylvania Adult and Family Literacy 29 30 Education Act, the Project Independence Act and the Job Enhancement Act. 31
