AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance,
- 4 providing for behavioral health and physical health services
- 5 integration.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
- 9 as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding a section to
- 10 read:
- 11 Section 443.13. Behavioral Health and Physical Health
- 12 <u>Services Integration.--(a) The department shall integrate into</u>
- 13 the HealthChoices medical assistance managed care program the
- 14 <u>following services for medical assistance-eligible persons:</u>
- 15 (1) Behavioral health services, including all mental health
- 16 and addiction services covered by medical assistance.
- 17 (2) Physical health services covered by medical assistance.
- 18 (3) All medication and specialty pharmacy drug benefits
- 19 <u>covered by medical assistance.</u>
- 20 (b) The department shall implement the integrated medical

- 1 <u>assistance managed care program by contracting with managed care</u>
- 2 organizations in a manner that:
- 3 (1) Ensures that each recipient receives high quality,
- 4 <u>comprehensive health care services in the recipient's local</u>
- 5 community within the least restrictive setting able to support
- 6 the recipient's needs.
- 7 (2) Develops strategies to address social determinants of
- 8 health.
- 9 (3) Provides optimal information exchange to support whole-
- 10 person care delivery.
- 11 (4) Provides for budget stability and predictability through
- 12 defined outcomes, performance and accountability.
- 13 (5) Balances the need for quality health care services,
- 14 patient satisfaction, prudent financial measures and self-
- 15 <u>sufficiency.</u>
- 16 (6) Ensures the most efficient and cost-effective health
- 17 care services, administrative systems and structures.
- 18 (7) Provides for a sustainable and uniform delivery system
- 19 across the Commonwealth's departments and agencies.
- 20 (8) Offers health care services to assist recipients in
- 21 attaining independence or self-care.
- 22 <u>(c) The department shall submit the appropriate waiver</u>
- 23 proposal to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for
- 24 approval of an amendment to the existing PA-67 waiver under
- 25 section 1915(b) of the Social Security Act (49 Stat. 620, 42
- 26 U.S.C. § 1396n(b)). The department shall submit for approval by
- 27 the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services the appropriate
- 28 waiver to integrate physical and behavioral health services by
- 29 October 1, 2021. The department shall:
- 30 (1) Provide medical assistance integrated benefits through

- 1 the most effective model of medical assistance capitated managed
- 2 care as determined by the department.
- 3 (2) Require mandatory participation in a medical assistance
- 4 <u>capitated managed care program for all persons eligible for</u>
- 5 medical assistance.
- 6 (3) Utilize the procurement process under 62 Pa.C.S. Pt. I
- 7 (relating to Commonwealth Procurement Code) for the integrated
- 8 program.
- 9 (d) As used in this section, the term "behavioral health
- 10 services" means mental disorders and substance-related and
- 11 addictive disorders. The term does not include intellectual
- 12 <u>developmental disorders.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
