A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for general appropriation bill.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby resolves as follows:
5	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
6	the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with
7	Article XI:
8	That Article VIII be amended by adding a section to read:
9	<u>§ 18. General appropriation bill.</u>
10	If the general appropriation bill is not enacted by the
11	constitutional deadline of June 30 in any year, the Commonwealth
12	shall maintain State appropriations at 80% of the amounts
13	specified in the general appropriation act for the most recent
14	<u>fiscal year.</u>
15	Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
16	Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
17	Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to

1 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
2 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
3 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
4 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
5 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

6 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this 7 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 8 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 9 10 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 11 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 12 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 13 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 14 15 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 16 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 17 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 18 19 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 20 passed by the General Assembly.
