AN ACT

- Amending Title 3 (Agriculture) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for the use of hemp in commercial animal feed.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 3 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes
- 7 is amended by adding a chapter to read:

- 11 <u>801</u>. <u>Definitions</u>.
- 12 <u>802</u>. Administration.
- 13 § 801. Definitions.
- 14 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 15 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 16 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 17 "Commercial feed." All material or combinations of material
- 18 that is distributed or intended for distribution for use as feed

- 1 or for mixing in feed, unless the material is specifically
- 2 excluded by law. The term includes the addition of hemp seed or
- 3 a substance derived from hemp seed for use as feed or for mixing
- 4 <u>in feed for a pet, specialty pet, horse or for other</u>
- 5 <u>nonproduction animals.</u>
- 6 "Industrial hemp." The plant Cannabis sativa L. and any part
- 7 of the plant, whether growing or not, with a delta-9
- 8 <u>tetrahydrocannabinol concentration of not more than 0.3% on a</u>
- 9 <u>dry-weight basis.</u>
- 10 § 802. Administration.
- 11 (a) Departmental duties. -- The department shall have the
- 12 <u>following duties:</u>
- 13 <u>(1) Implement this chapter.</u>
- 14 (2) Notwithstanding any provision of Chapter 71
- 15 (relating to seed) and its attendant regulations, to regulate
- 16 <u>the labeling and testing of industrial hemp and industrial</u>
- hemp seeds within this Commonwealth, including in commercial
- 18 <u>feed</u>.
- 19 (3) To establish, through regulation, recordkeeping
- requirements necessary to administer this chapter.
- 21 (b) Secretary.--If the secretary determines that a Federal
- 22 agency is authorized to regulate industrial hemp, the secretary
- 23 <u>shall transmit notice of that authorization to the Legislative</u>
- 24 Reference Bureau for publication in the next available
- 25 <u>Pennsylvania Bulletin.</u>
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
