AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 8, 1891 (P.L.212, No.184), entitled "An
- act in relation to cremation of human bodies in this
- 3 Commonwealth," providing for cremation temperature.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The act of June 8, 1891 (P.L.212, No.184),
- 7 entitled "An act in relation to cremation of human bodies in
- 8 this Commonwealth," is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 Section 2.1. Gases generated by the combustion in a
- 10 crematory incinerator shall be subject to a minimum temperature
- 11 of one thousand six hundred degrees Fahrenheit for a period of
- 12 not less than one second. The Department of Environmental
- 13 Protection may not require a cremation to occur at a temperature
- 14 greater than the temperature set forth in this section. The
- 15 temperature at which a crematory incinerator is operated shall
- 16 <u>be monitored. Monitoring shall be conducted in accordance with</u>
- 17 regulations promulgated by the Department of Environmental
- 18 Protection. This section only applies to a crematory incinerator
- 19 for which construction commenced after April 17, 1989.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
