## AN ACT

7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 104(b) of the act of November 10, 1999
10	(P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code
11	Act, amended or added July 15, 2004 (P.L.748, No.92), July 7,
12	2006 (P.L.1052, No.108) and July 17, 2007 (P.L.132, No.39), is
13	amended to read:
14	Section 104. Application.

16	(b) ExclusionsThis act shall not apply to:
17	(1) new buildings or renovations to existing buildings
18	for which an application for a building permit has been made
19	to the municipality prior to the effective date of the
20	regulations promulgated under this act;

1 (2) new buildings or renovations to existing buildings 2 on which a contract for design or construction has been 3 signed prior to the effective date of the regulations 4 promulgated under this act on projects requiring department 5 approval;

6 (3) utility and miscellaneous use structures that are
7 accessory to detached one-family dwellings;

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(4) any agricultural building;

9 (5) alterations to residential buildings which do not 10 make structural changes or changes to means of egress, except 11 as might be required by ordinances in effect pursuant to 12 section 303(b)(1) or adopted pursuant to section 503. For 13 purposes of this paragraph, a structural change does not 14 include a minor framing change needed to replace existing 15 windows or doors;

16 (6) repairs to residential buildings, except as might be
17 required by ordinances in effect pursuant to section 303(b)
18 (1) or adopted pursuant to section 503;

19 (6.1) the installation of aluminum siding or vinyl 20 siding onto an existing residential or an existing commercial 21 building, except as might be required by ordinances in effect 22 pursuant to section 301 or adopted pursuant to section 503;

23 (7) any recreational cabin if:

(i) the cabin is equipped with at least one smoke
detector, one fire extinguisher and one carbon monoxide
detector in both the kitchen and sleeping quarters;

27 (ii) the owner of the cabin files with the28 municipality either:

29 (A) an affidavit on a form prescribed by the
 30 department attesting to the fact that the cabin meets

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1 the definition of a "recreational cabin" in section 2 103; or 3 (B) a valid proof of insurance for the recreational cabin, written and issued by an insurer 4 5 authorized to do business in this Commonwealth, stating that the structure meets the definition of a 6 7 "recreational cabin" as defined in section 103; [and] 8 (8) temporary structures which are: 9 (i) [Erected] erected for the purpose of 10 participation in a fair, flea market, arts and crafts festival or other public celebration[.]; 11 12 (ii) [Less] <u>less</u> than 1,600 square feet in size[.]; 13 (iii) [Erected] erected for a period of less than 30 14 days[.]; 15 (iv) [Not] not a swimming pool, spa or hot tub[.]; 16 and (v) [Subject] <u>subject</u> to section 503(a)(2)[.]; 17 18 (9) decks that are: (i) no more than 30 inches above grade at any point; 19 20 and 21 (ii) attached or accessory to a residential building; 22 23 (10) accessory structures that are: 24 (i) attached to a residential building that cover an 25 entranceway; and 26 (ii) no more than one story high and not more than 200 square feet; and 27 28 (11) patio covers as defined in Appendix H of the 2009 29 International Residential Code for One- and Two-Family Dwellings or its successor requirement. 30

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- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
