Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in veteran-owned small businesses, further providing for definitions; adding miscellaneous-<-provisions relating to PROVIDING FOR veteran-owned business <-logotype and nonprofit membership association; and imposing a <-penalty. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The definition of "veteran" in section 9601 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to 11 read: \$ 9601. Definitions. 12 13 Subject to section 9602 (relating to regulations), the 14 following words and phrases when used in this chapter shall have 15 the meanings given to them in this section unless the context 16 clearly indicates otherwise: * * * 17 "Veteran." [An individual who served in the United States 18

- Armed Forces, including a reserve component or the National 1 Guard, and who was discharged or released from service under-2 3 conditions other than dishonorable. | Any of the following: (1) An individual who served on active duty in the 4 5 United States Armed Forces, including the Reserve and 6 National Guard, who was discharged or released from service 7 under honorable conditions. 8 (2) A reservist or member of the National Guard who 9 completed an initial term of enlistment or qualifying period 10 of service. (3) A reservist or member of the National Guard who was 11 disabled in the line of duty during training. 12 * * * 13 Section 2. - "Nonprofit membership association." A nonprofit_organization_<--28

2	a veteran. A BUSINESS IS CONTROLLED OR OWNED BY A VETERAN IF AT <-
3	LEAST 51% OF THE OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN THE BUSINESS IS HELD BY A
4	<u>VETERAN.</u>
5	§ 9622. Veteran-owned business logotype.
6	(a) Logotype. Except as provided under section 9623
7	(relating to nonprofit membership association), the department
8	shall develop and design an official Commonwealth logotype to be
9	used by a veteran owned business.
0 ـ	(b) Application. Except as provided under section 9623, the
1	department shall develop an application, criteria and
_2	affirmation upon which an eligible business may apply for a
_3	license to use the logotype under this section.
4	(c) Eligibility. A veteran owned business shall be eligible
.5	to be issued a license to use the logotype if:
- 6	(1) the business is registered with the Department of
_7	State; and
8_	(2) at least 51% of the ownership interest in the
_9	business is held by a veteran.
20	(d) Verification of military service status. Except as
21	provided under section 9623, the following shall apply:
22	(1) The department shall verify the military service
23	status of each business owner seeking status as a veteran-
24	owned business without additional verification, by confirming
25	that the business:
26	(i) Possesses a valid verification issued by the
27	Department of General Services as a Veteran Business
28	Enterprise, including a Veteran Owned Small Business
29	Enterprise or a Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small
30	Business Enterprise.

1	(ii) Possesses a valid verification issued by the
2	United States Department of Veterans Affairs through
3	<u>VETBIZ or its successor.</u>
4	(2) Nothing under this subsection shall prohibit the
5	department from working with another State agency or an
6	additional third party entity to establish veteran owned
7	business verification.
8	(e) Notice. Within 10 days of the creation of a logotype
9	under this section and the establishment of the criteria
10	necessary to use and display the logotype and the applications
11	and instructions on how to complete and submit an application,
12	the department shall post on a publicly accessible Internet
13	website of the department, a notice that:
14	(1) The logotype under this section is available to an
15	eligible business.
16	(2) Includes the criteria necessary to receive a license
17	to use and display the logotype and allows for access to the
18	applications and instructions on how to complete and submit
19	the applications.
20	(f) Issuance. Except as provided under section 9623, the
21	department shall issue a license to use and display the logotype
22	to an applicant deemed eligible under subsection (c).
23	(A) LOGOTYPE
24	(1) NO LATER THAN 30 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
25	THIS PARAGRAPH, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP AND DESIGN AN
26	OFFICIAL VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS LOGOTYPE TO BE USED BY A
27	VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS.
28	(2) THE LOGOTYPE SHALL NOT INCLUDE ANY LANGUAGE THAT MAY
29	BE CONSTRUED AS AN ENDORSEMENT BY THIS COMMONWEALTH AND SHALL
2 0	ONLY INDICATE THAT THE DISTNESS IS A VETERAN OWNED DISTNESS

- 6 WEBSITE.
- 7 (C) ELIGIBILITY.--THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP GUIDELINES
- 8 WITH THE CRITERIA TO ESTABLISH VETERAN-OWNED STATUS OF
- 9 BUSINESSES APPLYING FOR THE LOGOTYPE. THE CRITERIA SHALL BE MADE
- 10 AVAILABLE ON THE DEPARTMENT'S PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET
- 11 WEBSITE.
- 12 (D) CONTRIBUTIONS.--THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROVIDE A SPACE ON
- 13 THE APPLICATION WHERE AN APPLICANT MAY VOLUNTARILY MAKE A
- 14 CONTRIBUTION OF ANY AMOUNT TO BE DEPOSITED INTO THE VETERANS'
- 15 TRUST FUND.
- 16 (E) NOTICE.--WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE CREATION OF A LOGOTYPE
- 17 UNDER THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL POST ON THE
- 18 DEPARTMENT'S PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE, A NOTICE
- 19 THAT:
- 20 <u>(1) THE LOGOTYPE UNDER THIS SECTION IS AVAILABLE FOR USE</u>
- 21 BY AN APPROVED VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS.
- 22 (2) INCLUDES INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO COMPLETE AND SUBMIT
- 23 AN APPLICATION.
- 24 (F) ISSUANCE.--WITHIN 60 DAYS OF RECEIVING AN APPLICATION
- 25 UNDER THIS SUBCHAPTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOTIFY THE APPLICANT
- 26 WHETHER THE APPLICANT IS APPROVED TO USE AND DISPLAY THE
- 27 LOGOTYPE.
- 28 <u>(q) Penalty.--</u>
- 29 (1) An IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PRESCRIBED BY <--
- 30 LAW, AN individual commits a misdemeanor of the third degree

- 1 <u>if the individual fraudulently holds the individual out to be</u>
- 2 <u>a veteran for the purpose of obtaining a license or using a <--</p></u>
- 3 logotype under this subchapter.
- 4 (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the full
- 5 <u>amount of each fine collected for a violation of paragraph</u>
- 6 (1) shall be deposited into the Veterans' Trust Fund.
- 7 (h) Report.--By March 31 of each year, the department shall
- 8 prepare an annual report on the number of veteran-owned
- 9 <u>businesses</u> <u>issued a license</u> APPROVED to use the logotype and the <--
- 10 <u>annual applications and renewals of the license to use the</u>
- 11 <u>logotype</u> NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS RECEIVED. A copy of the report <--
- 12 shall be sent to the Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness
- 13 Committee of the Senate and the Veterans Affairs and Emergency
- 14 <u>Preparedness Committee of the House of Representatives.</u>
