1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12	Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to elections," providing for early voting in primaries and elections.
13	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known
16	as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding an
17	article to read:
18	ARTICLE XII-A
19	CONDUCT OF EARLY VOTING
20	IN PRIMARIES AND ELECTIONS
21	Section 1201-A. Early voting period.
22	A county board shall provide for early voting to begin 15

1	days prior to the dates of primaries and elections established	
2	in accordance with Article VI and to end 14 days after the	
3	starting date.	
4	Section 1202-A. Early voting sites.	
5	<u>A county board shall designate early voting sites where</u>	
6	electors may cast their ballots during the early voting period	
7	established in accordance with section 1201-A. These sites shall	
8	include the main office of the county board and any other sites	
9	designated by the county board. The county board shall make	
10	available at these sites the same equipment used on election day	
11	as provided for in Article XI. The early voting sites shall be	
12	geographically located to provide electors in the election	
13	district an equal opportunity to cast a ballot.	
14	Section 1203-A. Days and times for opening and closing polls at	
15	early voting sites.	
16	<u>A county board shall designate the days and hours that early</u>	
17	voting sites will be open, provided that all sites throughout	
18	the county shall have uniform days and hours, shall be open	
19	eight hours each weekday, shall be open a minimum of an	
20	aggregate eight hours each weekend, and shall not open prior to	
21	<u>7 a.m. Eastern Standard Time or close before 7 p.m. Eastern</u>	
22	Standard Time.	
23	Section 1204-A. Voting check list.	
24	<u>A county board shall maintain a voting check list as provided</u>	
25	for in section 1212 in order to ensure that electors are	
26	prohibited from casting additional ballots at either an early	
27	voting site or on election day in their precinct.	
28	Section 1205-A. Disposition of returns.	
29	<u>A county board shall track votes by precinct but may not</u>	
30	tabulate votes prior to the close of the polls on election day.

1 <u>Section 1206-A.</u> Notice of early voting.

2 <u>A county board shall, not earlier than 15 days nor later than</u>

3 nine days before each November election, give notice of early

4 voting by newspaper publication in the county in accordance with

5 the provisions of section 106. The notice shall be published

6 twice in counties of the first class and once in all other

7 counties. A county board shall also post the notice on the

8 <u>county board's publicly accessible Internet website.</u>

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
