AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in Department of Military Affairs,
- 3 establishing the PA VETConnect Program.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 714. PA VETConnect Program.
- 9 (a) Establishment. -- The PA VETConnect Program is
- 10 <u>established</u>.
- 11 (b) Participants. -- The program may include Federal agencies,
- 12 State agencies, county directors of veterans' affairs, veterans'
- 13 <u>service organizations</u>, <u>accredited postsecondary educational and</u>
- 14 technical institutions, the health care provider community,
- 15 <u>businesses</u> and nonprofit organizations.
- 16 (c) Purpose. -- The program shall:
- 17 (1) Improve the health and well-being of veterans and
- 18 the families of veterans through referrals, community

- 1 engagement and consistent network communication.
- 2 (2) Organize participants under subsection (b) to
- 3 <u>cooperate with network partners to provide for proactive</u>
- 4 <u>solutions to address the problems faced by veterans.</u>
- 5 (d) Requirements. -- Program requirements shall be determined
- 6 by the department and information shall be disseminated to the
- 7 greatest extent possible on how to best navigate and utilize
- 8 available resources to improve the health and well-being of
- 9 <u>veterans and the families of veterans.</u>
- 10 (e) Duties of department. -- The department shall develop the
- 11 program, which shall contain a mission statement that shall be
- 12 clearly communicated to network advocates, partners and
- 13 participants under subsection (b). The department shall:
- 14 (1) Coordinate with Federal agencies, State agencies,
- county directors of veterans' affairs, veterans' service
- organizations, accredited postsecondary educational and
- 17 technical institutions, the health care provider community,
- businesses and nonprofit organizations, identified by the
- 19 department, that provide programs, initiatives, reintegration
- 20 <u>outreach and related services to veterans and the families of</u>
- 21 veterans.
- 22 (2) Provide Welcome Home to Pennsylvania information to
- 23 <u>recently separated service members.</u>
- 24 (3) Provide information regarding program initiatives,
- 25 resources, training opportunities, veterans' service
- organizations and services available to be utilized by
- 27 <u>individuals or groups who support veterans and their families</u>
- as volunteers and offer outreach and support for veterans.
- 29 (4) Coordinate with county directors of veterans'
- 30 affairs by providing information of veterans who request

- 1 <u>support for Federal and State benefits and programs.</u>
- 2 (5) Coordinate with veterans' service officers from
- 3 veterans' service officer grant programs or other veterans'
- 4 <u>service officers to assist veterans in applying for Federal</u>
- 5 veteran benefits.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
