8	§ 708. Executive sessions.
9	(a) PurposeAn agency may hold an executive session for
10	one or more of the following reasons:

12	(2) To hold information[,] <u>and</u> strategy [and
13	negotiation] sessions related to [the negotiation or
14	arbitration of] a collective bargaining agreement or, in the
15	absence of a collective bargaining unit, related to labor
16	relations and arbitration. This paragraph does not apply to
17	negotiation sessions related to collective bargaining
18	agreements.
