## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, 5 further providing for physical education. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1512.1 of the act of March 10, 1949 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 11 amended to read: Section 1512.1. Physical Education. - (a) The board of 12 <--13 school directors in every school district shall establish a 14 curriculum aligned with Pennsylvania academic standards on 15 health, safety and physical education that pursuant to 22 Pa. 16 Code § 4.27 (relating to physical education and athletics), requires pupils enrolled in the district to participate in-17 18 physical education. 19 (b) The board of school directors shall 20 satisfy the physical education curriculum requirement under-

- 1 subsection (a) by participation in an interscholastic sport. A
- 2 student may utilize participation in an interscholastic sport to
- 3 <u>satisfy the physical education requirement twice per school</u>
- 4 year, the utilization of which must be during the
- 5 interscholastic sport's season.
- 6 (c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 7 <u>shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless</u>
- 8 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 9 <u>"Interscholastic sport" shall mean athletic contests or</u>
- 10 competitions conducted between or among schools.
- 11 SECTION 1512.1. PHYSICAL EDUCATION.--(A) THE BOARD OF

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- 12 SCHOOL DIRECTORS IN EVERY SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL ESTABLISH A
- 13 CURRICULUM ALIGNED WITH PENNSYLVANIA ACADEMIC STANDARDS ON
- 14 HEALTH, SAFETY AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION THAT PURSUANT TO 22 PA.
- 15 CODE § 4.27 (RELATING TO PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND ATHLETICS),
- 16 REQUIRES PUPILS ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO PARTICIPATE
- 17 IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION.
- 18 (B) THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:
- 19 (1) BEGINNING IN THE 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR AND IN EACH
- 20 SCHOOL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE BOARD OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS MAY PERMIT
- 21 STUDENTS TO SATISFY PHYSICAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS BY
- 22 PARTICIPATING IN INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS.
- 23 (2) THE BOARD OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS PERMITTING SATISFACTION
- 24 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) SHALL DEVELOP A POLICY OR REVISE AN EXISTING
- 25 POLICY TO PERMIT STUDENTS TO SATISFY PHYSICAL EDUCATION
- 26 <u>REQUIREMENTS BY PARTICIPATING IN INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS.</u>
- 27 (C) UTILIZATION OF INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS TO SATISFY
- 28 PHYSICAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS MAY SATISFY COMPONENTS OF THE
- 29 ACADEMIC STANDARDS FOR HEALTH, SAFETY AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION
- 30 UNDER 22 PA. CODE CH. 4 APPEN. D (RELATING TO ACADEMIC STANDARDS

- 1 FOR THE ARTS AND HUMANITIES AND HEALTH, SAFETY AND PHYSICAL
- 2 EDUCATION AND FAMILY AND CONSUMER SCIENCES) BUT MAY NOT SERVE AS
- 3 A COMPLETE WAIVER OR EXEMPTION FROM THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND
- 4 PHYSICAL EDUCATION ACADEMIC STANDARDS.
- 5 (D) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES
- 6 SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SUBSECTION UNLESS
- 7 THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 8 "INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS." ATHLETIC CONTESTS OR
- 9 <u>COMPETITIONS CONDUCTED BETWEEN OR AMONG SCHOOL ENTITIES SITUATED</u>
- 10 IN A SCHOOL DISTRICT.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
