22	(b) The term "employer" includes the Commonwealth or any

political subdivision or board, department, commission or school 1 district thereof and any person employing [four] one or more 2 persons within the Commonwealth, but except as hereinafter 3 provided, does not include religious, fraternal, charitable or 4 sectarian corporations or associations, except such corporations 5 or associations supported, in whole or in part, by governmental 6 appropriations. The term "employer" with respect to 7 8 discriminatory practices based on race, color, age, sex, national origin or non-job related handicap or disability, 9 10 includes religious, fraternal, charitable and sectarian corporations and associations employing [four] one or more 11 12 persons within the Commonwealth.
