## AN ACT

Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in 2 firearms and other dangerous articles, further providing for prohibited conduct during emergency; and, in the Governor and disaster emergencies, further providing for general authority 5 of Governor. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 9 Section 1. Section 6107(a) and (b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 10 11 § 6107. Prohibited conduct during emergency. General rule. -- No person shall carry a firearm upon the 12 13 public streets or upon any public property during an emergency proclaimed by a State or municipal governmental executive unless 14 15 that person is: 16 (1) Actively engaged in a defense of that person's life 17 or property from peril or threat. Licensed to carry firearms under section 6109 18 19 (relating to licenses) or is exempt from licensing under

- without a license).]
