## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for expiration of authority to levy or collect real property taxes on homesteads and farmsteads. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby resolves as follows: 6 7 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI: 8 9 That Article VIII be amended by adding a section to read:
- § 18. Expiration of authority to levy or collect real property 10
- 11 taxes on homesteads and farmsteads.
- 12 (a) No school district may levy a real property tax on a
- 13 homestead or farmstead after June 30, 2026. This subsection
- 14 shall not prohibit a school district from collecting a tax
- 15 levied prior to June 30, 2026.
- 16 (b) The Legislature shall, by general law, provide annually
- 17 each school district with maintenance and support in an amount
- 18 at least equal to the real property tax collected by the school
- 19 district on homesteads and farmsteads during the fiscal year

- 1 ending June 30, 2026, less the annual debt service legally
- 2 <u>obligated to be paid by the school district during the fiscal</u>
- 3 year ending June 30, 2026. The maintenance and support of school
- 4 <u>districts may include</u>, but need not be limited to:
- 5 (1) A State tax on each separate sale at retail of tangible
- 6 personal property or services in this Commonwealth.
- 7 (2) A State tax on the receipt of income by every resident
- 8 individual, estate or trust.
- 9 (3) A local tax on the receipt of income by every resident
- 10 individual, estate or trust.
- 11 (4) A local tax on earned income and net profits.
- (c) Under no circumstances may the General Assembly provide,
- 13 by general, local or special law, for a real property tax on a
- 14 <u>homestead or farmstead.</u>
- 15 (d) Except for taxes imposed under subsection (b) (3) and
- 16 (4), all proceeds from other taxes imposed under subsection (b),
- 17 shall be deposited into a separate fund in the State Treasury,
- 18 to be known as the Stabilization of Education Fund, and shall be
- 19 used for the purpose of the maintenance and support of school
- 20 <u>districts required under subsection (a). The money in the fund</u>
- 21 may not be diverted by transfer or otherwise to any other
- 22 <u>purpose</u>.
- 23 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
- 24 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
- 25 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
- 26 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 27 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 28 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 29 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 30 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

- 1 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
- 2 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the
- 3 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 4 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 5 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 6 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
- 7 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 8 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the
- 9 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment
- 10 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 11 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 12 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 13 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 14 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is
- 15 passed by the General Assembly.
