## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 2, 2019 (P.L.366, No.56), entitled "An
- act providing for sports raffles for charity; and making
- 3 related repeals," further providing for athletic event
- 4 drawing.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 4(e) of the act of July 2, 2019 (P.L.366,
- 8 No.56), known as the Sports Raffle Charities Act, is amended and
- 9 the section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 10 Section 4. Athletic event drawing.
- 11 \* \* \*
- 12 (e) Distribution. -- The prize amount of an athletic event
- 13 drawing shall be 50% of the total amount collected from the sale
- 14 of athletic event drawing tickets. Except as provided under
- 15 subsection (f), the other 50% of the total amount collected from
- 16 the sale of athletic event drawing tickets shall be donated
- 17 [within seven days from the date of the drawing] by the
- 18 affiliated nonprofit organization conducting the athletic event

Τ	drawing [to one] in accordance with the following:
2	(1) Forty-five percent of the other 50% of the total
3	amount collected from the sale of athletic event drawing
4	tickets shall be donated within seven days from the date of
5	the drawing to one or more designated charitable
6	organizations for which the drawing was conducted and shall
7	be used exclusively for public interest purposes.
8	(2) Five percent of the other 50% of the total amount
9	collected from the sale of athletic event drawing tickets
10	shall be used to fund grants issued by the Office of State
11	Fire Commissioner under 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 78 Subchs. B (relating
12	to Fire Company Grant Program) and C (relating to Emergency
13	Medical Services Grant Program). No later than June 30, 2024,
14	and each June 30 thereafter, the affiliated nonprofit
15	organization shall remit the amount collected under this
16	paragraph in the prior year to the department. The department
17	shall report the amount remitted under this paragraph to the
18	State Treasurer. The State Treasurer shall transfer the
19	amount to a restricted revenue account within the General
20	Fund to fund grants issued by the Office of State Fire
21	Commissioner under 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 78 Subchs. B and C.

23	(k.1) Report
24	(1) The affiliated nonprofit organization shall compile
25	a report with all of the following information for the prior
26	<u>year:</u>
27	(i) The total amount collected from the sale of
28	athletic event drawing tickets.
29	(ii) The total amount donated to one or more
30	designated charitable organizations for which the

1	athletic event drawing was conducted under subsection (e)
2	<u>(1).</u>
3	(iii) The total amount remitted under subsection (e)
4	(2) to fund grants issued by the Office of State Fire
5	Commissioner under 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 78 Subchs. B and C.
6	(2) No later than September 30, 2024, and each September
7	30 thereafter, the affiliated nonprofit organization shall
8	submit the report under paragraph (1) to the State Treasurer
9	on a form prescribed by the State Treasurer. The State
10	Treasurer shall submit the report to all of the following:
11	(i) The department.
12	(ii) The chair and minority chair of the
13	Appropriations Committee of the Senate.
14	(iii) The chair and minority chair of the
15	Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.
16	(iv) The chair and minority chair of the Veterans
17	Affairs and Emergency Preparedness Committee of the
18	<u>Senate.</u>
19	(v) The chair and minority chair of the Veterans
20	Affairs and Emergency Preparedness Committee of the House
21	of Representatives.

23	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
