AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in particular rights and
- immunities, providing for limited liability for pilots and
- 4 apprentices.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 8340.3. Licensed pilot liability.
- 10 (a) Purpose. -- The purpose of this section is to stimulate
- 11 and preserve maritime commerce on the pilotage grounds of this
- 12 Commonwealth by limiting and regulating the liability of certain
- 13 pilots, which commerce is essential to the economic viability of
- 14 this Commonwealth's maritime commerce and serves the public
- 15 <u>interests</u>.
- 16 (b) Limited liability. -- A licensed pilot or apprentice
- 17 providing pilot services shall not be liable for more than
- 18 \$5,000 for damage or loss caused by the licensed pilot's or
- 19 apprentice's error, omission, fault or neglect in the

- 1 performance of the pilot services, except for the following:
- 2 (1) damage or loss that arises because of the willful
- 3 misconduct or reckless disregard for safety by the licensed
- 4 <u>pilot or apprentice; or</u>
- 5 (2) an act or omission relating to the ownership and
- 6 operation of a pilot boat unless the pilot boat is directly
- 7 <u>involved in pilot services other than the transportation of</u>
- 8 <u>licensed pilots.</u>
- 9 (c) Vessel owners and operators. -- This section does not
- 10 exempt a vessel or its owner or operator from liability for
- 11 damage or loss caused by the vessel to a person or property on
- 12 <u>the grounds that:</u>
- 13 (1) the vessel was piloted by a licensed pilot or
- 14 <u>apprentice; or</u>
- 15 (2) the damage or loss was caused by the error,
- omission, fault or neglect of a licensed pilot or apprentice.
- 17 (d) Dismissal of proceedings. -- In a proceeding brought
- 18 against a licensed pilot or apprentice for an act or omission
- 19 for which liability is limited as provided by this section and
- 20 in which other claims are made or anticipated with respect to
- 21 the same act or omission the court shall dismiss the proceedings
- 22 as to the licensed pilot or apprentice to the extent the
- 23 pleadings allege liability of the pilot that exceeds \$5,000.
- 24 (e) Other limitations of liability.--Liability under this
- 25 section shall also be limited as follows:
- 26 (1) A pilot or apprentice shall not be liable directly
- or as a member of an organization of pilots for any claim
- 28 <u>that:</u>
- 29 (i) arises from an act or omission of another pilot,
- 30 apprentice or organization of pilots; and

- 1 <u>(ii) relates directly or indirectly to pilot</u>
- 2 <u>services.</u>
- 3 (2) An organization of pilots shall not be liable for
- 4 <u>any damages caused by a licensed pilot's or apprentice's</u>
- 5 <u>error, omission, fault or neglect in the performance of</u>
- 6 <u>pilotage</u>.
- 7 <u>(f) Defense.--For the sole purpose of occasions when this</u>
- 8 <u>section is applicable as a defense to liability by a licensed</u>
- 9 pilot or apprentice, the licensed pilot or apprentice asserting
- 10 the defense shall be considered to have been acting as the
- 11 servant of the vessel, its owner and its operator.
- 12 (g) Applicability. -- This section shall apply to all causes
- 13 of action that occur on or after July 1, 2015.
- (h) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 15 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 16 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 17 "Apprentice." A person appointed as an apprentice pilot
- 18 under 4 Pa. Code Ch. 405.9 (relating to apprentices).
- 19 "Pilot." A person licensed under 4 Pa. Code Ch. 405
- 20 (relating to pilots and pilotage) by the Navigation Commission
- 21 for the Delaware River and its Navigable Tributaries.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
