## AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987, No.442), entitled
  "An act relating to public works contracts; providing for

- 8 Section 1. Section 2(3) of the act of August 15, 1961
- 9 (P.L.987, No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage
- 10 Act, is amended to read:
- 11 Section 2. Definitions. -- As used in this act--
- 12 \* \* \*
- 13 (3) "Maintenance work" means the repair of existing
- 14 facilities when the size, type or extent of such facilities is
- 15 not thereby changed or increased. The term includes the
- 16 <u>following actions taken on roads:</u>
- 17 <u>(i) Replacement in kind, or compliance with current</u>
- 18 Department of Transportation design criteria and standards, of
- 19 quide rails, curbs, pipes, line painting and other related road

- 1 <u>equipment</u>.
- 2 <u>(ii) Repair of pavement service by:</u>
- 3 (A) laying bituminous material up to three and one-half
- 4 inches thick or up to four hundred twenty pounds per square yard
- 5 on asphalt pavement, cement concrete or other hard surface,
- 6 <u>including associated milling</u>, and related work raising existing
- 7 paved shoulders to new grade; or
- 8 (B) patching of cement concrete surface to include joint
- 9 spalling and repair work.
- 10 (iii) Widening of existing alignment which does not result
- 11 in additional lanes or new shoulders.
- 12 (iv) Bridge cleaning, washing, resurfacing with blacktop,
- 13 minor nonstructural repairs or improvements and painting, except
- 14 when combined with complete bridge rehabilitation.

- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
