## AN ACT

- Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in COVID-19 disaster emergency, 2 providing for COVID-19 vaccine. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. - 16 § 5753. Local pharmacy inclusion.
- (a) General rule. -- Except as otherwise provided, the 17
- department must include at least two local pharmacies in each 18

- 1 county under the jurisdiction of the department in the
- 2 <u>implementation of the Commonwealth's COVID-19 Interim</u>
- 3 Vaccination Plan. A pharmacy under this section must have been
- 4 approved as a COVID-19 vaccine provider and employ a certified
- 5 immunizing pharmacist.
- 6 (b) Exception. -- If a county under the jurisdiction of the
- 7 <u>department cannot comply with the requirements of subsection</u>
- 8 (a), the department shall include any local pharmacy in a county
- 9 <u>under subsection (a).</u>
- 10 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 11 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 12 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 <u>"COVID-19." The novel coronavirus as identified in the</u>
- 14 Governor's proclamation of disaster emergency issued on March 6,
- 15 <u>2020</u>, <u>published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020)</u>.
- 16 "COVID-19 Interim Vaccination Plan." Version 8.0 of the
- 17 Commonwealth's COVID-19 Interim Vaccination Plan published March
- 18 31, 2021.
- 19 "COVID-19 vaccine." A vaccine for COVID-19 that has received
- 20 emergency use authorization from the United States Food and Drug
- 21 Administration.
- 22 "Department." The Department of Health of the Commonwealth.
- 23 "Local pharmacy." A pharmacy, as defined under section 2(12)
- 24 of the act of September 27, 1961 (P.L.1700, No.699), known as
- 25 the Pharmacy Act, that is independent and solely owned and
- 26 operated in this Commonwealth. The term does not include a
- 27 <u>retail chain pharmacy.</u>
- 28 "Provider." A COVID-19 vaccine provider approved by the
- 29 Department of Health to distribute and administer COVID-19
- 30 vaccine doses in this Commonwealth.

- 1 "Retail chain pharmacy." A pharmacy, as defined under
- 2 <u>section 2(12) of the Pharmacy Act, operating 12 or more</u>
- 3 pharmacies in this Commonwealth and is not independent and
- 4 solely owned and operated, or a vaccine provider contracted
- 5 through the Federal Retail Pharmacy Program for COVID-19
- 6 <u>Vaccination</u>.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
