AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An
 2 act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying
 3 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing
 4 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment,
 5 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing
 6 for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and
 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain
 8 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations
 9 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and
 10 penalties," providing for contributions for American Red
 11 Cross.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. The act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as
 15 the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by adding a section to
 16 read:

17 Section 315.10. Contributions for American Red Cross.--(a)
 18 The department shall provide a space on the Pennsylvania
 19 individual income tax return form by which an individual may
 20 voluntarily designate a contribution of any amount desired to
 21 the American Red Cross.

1 (b) The amount designated under subsection (a) by an
2 individual on the income tax return form shall be deducted from
3 the tax refund to which the individual is entitled and shall not
4 constitute a charge against the income tax revenues due the
5 Commonwealth.

6 (c) The department shall determine annually the total amount
7 designated under this section, less reasonable administrative
8 costs, and shall report the amount to the State Treasurer, who
9 shall transfer the amount from the General Fund to the American
10 Red Cross.

11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
