## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for the offense of aggravated assault.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 2702(a) and (b) of Title 18 of the
7	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
8	§ 2702. Aggravated assault.
9	(a) Offense definedA person is guilty of aggravated
10	assault if he:
11	(1) attempts to cause serious bodily injury to another,
12	or causes such injury intentionally, knowingly or recklessly
13	under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the
14	value of human life;
15	(2) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
16	recklessly causes serious bodily injury to any of the
17	officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in
18	subsection (c) or to an employee of an agency, company or

other entity engaged in public transportation, while in the
 performance of duty;

3 (3) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly
4 causes bodily injury to any of the officers, agents,
5 employees or other persons enumerated in subsection (c), in
6 the performance of duty;

7 (4) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly
8 causes bodily injury to another with a deadly weapon;

9 attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly (5) 10 causes bodily injury to a teaching staff member, school board member or other employee, including a student employee, of 11 12 any elementary or secondary publicly-funded educational 13 institution, any elementary or secondary private school 14 licensed by the Department of Education or any elementary or 15 secondary parochial school while acting in the scope of his 16 or her employment or because of his or her employment 17 relationship to the school;

(6) attempts by physical menace to put any of the officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in subsection (c), while in the performance of duty, in fear of imminent serious bodily injury;

(7) uses tear or noxious gas as defined in section
2708(b) (relating to use of tear or noxious gas in labor
disputes) or uses an electric or electronic incapacitation
device against any officer, employee or other person
enumerated in subsection (c) while acting in the scope of his
employment;

(8) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
recklessly causes bodily injury to a child less than six
years of age, by a person 18 years of age or older; [or]

1	(9) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
2	recklessly causes serious bodily injury to a child less than
3	13 years of age, by a person 18 years of age or older[.] <u>; or</u>
4	(10) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
5	recklessly causes bodily injury to a person who is an
6	employee of an establishment which has physical distancing
7	requirements and a mask or face covering requirement as a
8	reaction to the employee enforcing the physical distancing
9	requirements or the mask or face covering requirement.
10	(b) GradingAggravated assault under subsection (a)(1),
11	(2) and (9) is a felony of the first degree. Aggravated assault
12	under subsection (a)(3), (4), (5), (6), (7) [and], (8) <u>and (10)</u>
13	is a felony of the second degree.

15	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
