## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, further providing for requirement for periodic
- 3 inspection of vehicles.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4702(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes, amended October 24, 2012 (P.L.1407,
- 8 No.174), is amended and the section is amended by adding a
- 9 subsection to read:
- 10 § 4702. Requirement for periodic inspection of vehicles.
- 11 (a) Annual safety inspection. -- Except as provided in
- 12 [subsection (b)] <u>subsections (b) and (b.1)</u>, the department shall
- 13 establish a system of annual safety inspection of vehicles,
- 14 including emergency vehicles, farm vehicles with a gross weight
- 15 or gross vehicle weight rating of greater than 17,000 pounds for
- 16 which a Type D biennial certificate of exemption has been issued
- 17 and private noncommercial vehicles used to transport students.

- 1 (b.1) New vehicles.--A vehicle shall be exempt from safety
- 2 <u>inspection requirements for the first two years after the</u>
- 3 <u>vehicle is manufactured. After the second year, the vehicle</u>
- 4 shall be subject to inspection as required in this section.

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
