4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

12	<u>§ 3401. Electric generating units.</u>
13	(a) InventoryThe department, in conjunction with the
14	Independent Fiscal Office, shall take an inventory of each
15	electric generating unit within this Commonwealth that emits
16	<u>carbon dioxide.</u>
17	(b) Analysis and report
18	(1) The department shall analyze the information

1	contained in the inventory under subsection (a) and use
2	economic impact assessment software to prepare a detailed
3	report that includes the following:
4	(i) The property taxes paid by the electric
5	generating unit in a taxing district, in relation to
6	total property tax revenue received by the taxing
7	<u>district.</u>
8	(ii) The total amount of wages paid to the employees
9	of the electric generating unit, the wage taxes paid by
10	the employees of the electric generating unit and the
11	municipalities that receive these wage tax revenues.
12	(iii) The payments for water, sewer and trash
13	services by the electric generating unit and the
14	municipalities or other entities that receive the
15	payments for the services.
16	(iv) The value of additional taxes or fees paid by
17	the electric generating unit and received by a taxing
18	district or the Commonwealth.
19	(v) The value of contracted services provided to the
20	electric generating unit, including the fuel used by the
21	electric generating unit to produce electricity,
22	materials purchased to meet environmental compliance
23	requirements, railroad services, trucking services,
24	maintenance, cleaning services, office supplies and
25	employees provided through an employment agency.
26	(2) Within 90 days of the effective date of this
27	section, the report under this subsection shall be submitted
28	<u>to:</u>
29	(i) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
30	Community, Economic and Recreational Development

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1	Committee of the Senate.
2	(ii) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
3	Commerce Committee of the House of Representatives.
4	(iii) Each taxing district of the electric
5	generating unit.
6	(c) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
7	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
8	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
9	"Department." The Department of Community and Economic
10	Development of the Commonwealth.
11	"Taxing district." A county, city, borough, incorporated
12	<u>town, township or school district.</u>
13	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
