16	participants shoot or attempt to shoot targets for either
17	<u>amusement or as a test of skill in marksmanship that are</u>
18	launched or otherwise immediately presented to the shooter

3	<u>field.</u>

8	(a) Offense definedA person commits a summary offense if
9	the person willfully organizes, operates or conducts a trap
10	shoot or block shoot in which live pigeons are used as targets.
11	(b) ApplicabilityNothing under this section shall be
12	construed to apply to activity which is authorized or permitted
13	under 34 Pa.C.S. (relating to game) or a special permit under 58
14	Pa. Code Ch. 147 (relating to special permits) or to the
15	training of dogs for activity which is authorized or permitted
16	<u>under 34 Pa.C.S.</u>
17	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
