AN ACT
Providing for a report by the Department of State on complaints relating to the 2020 general election.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Short title.
This act shall be known and may be cited as the 2020 General Election Report Act. Section 2. Definitions.

The following words and phrases when used in this act shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
"Department." The Department of State of the Commonwealth.
"Election." The general election held on November 3, 2020. Section 3. Report.
(a) General rule.--The department shall submit a report to

16 the General Assembly regarding how the following complaints
17 relating to the election were investigated:
(1) Complaints submitted to the Bureau of Commissions, Elections and Legislation of the department regarding violations of Title III of the Help America Vote Act of 2002 (Public Law 107-252, 52 U.S.C. § 20901 et seq.).
(2) Complaints submitted to the department through the department's formal election complaint publicly accessible Internet website.
(3) Complaints submitted to the department through the voter hotline.
(b) Contents.--The information in the report under subsection (a) shall include the complaint, polling precinct and county in which the complaint originated, what actions the department took to investigate the complaint and the outcome of the investigation.
(c) Submission.--The department shall submit the report to the General Assembly within 30 days of the effective date of this section.

Section 4. Effective date.
This act shall take effect immediately.
