## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in riot, disorderly conduct and 2 related offenses, further providing for the offense of cruelty to animals. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 5511(q) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition and the 8 section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 10 § 5511. Cruelty to animals. 11 \* \* \* (c.1) Use of live pigeons for targets at trap shoot or block 12 13 shoot prohibited. --14 (1) A person commits a summary offense if that person 15 willfully organizes, operates or conducts a trap shoot or 16 block shoot in which live pigeons are used as targets. 17 (2) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to apply to activity which is authorized or permitted under 34 18

- 15 <u>a fixed location or locations within a predefined shooting</u>
