A Class C license shall be issued to those 19 persons 18 years of age or older, except as provided in

1 section 1503 (relating to persons ineligible for licensing; 2 license issuance to minors; junior driver's license), who 3 have demonstrated their qualifications to operate any singlevehicle, except those vehicles requiring a Class M-4 5 qualification, with a gross vehicle weight rating of not more-6 than 26,000 pounds or any combination of vehicles, except-7 combination vehicles involving motorcycles, that does not 8 meet the definition of either Class A or Class B of this 9 section. 10 11 (v) Any driver who is the holder of a Class Clicense shall be authorized to operate a covered farm 12 13 vehicle, regardless of the other requirements of this 14 section as to the class of license required. 15 16 (D.1) OPERATION OF COVERED FARM VEHICLE. -- NOTWITHSTANDING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (D) RELATING TO CLASS OF LICENSE 17 18 REQUIRED, ANY DRIVER WHO IS THE HOLDER OF A CLASS A, B OR C 19 LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO OPERATE A 20 COVERED FARM VEHICLE. * * * 21 (F) PENALTY.--[A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (D.1), 22 23 A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) COMMITS A SUMMARY OFFENSE 24 AND SHALL, UPON CONVICTION, BE SENTENCED TO PAY A FINE OF UP TO \$200, EXCEPT THAT, IF THE PERSON CHARGED FURNISHES SATISFACTORY 25 26 PROOF OF HAVING HELD THE PROPER CLASS OF LICENSE VALID ON THE LAST DAY OF THE PRECEDING DRIVER'S LICENSE PERIOD AND NO MORE 27 28 THAN SIX MONTHS HAVE ELAPSED FROM THE LAST DATE FOR RENEWAL, THE 29 FINE SHALL BE \$25.
