8	§ 2710. Ethnic intimidation.
9	(a) Offense definedA person commits the offense of ethnic
10	intimidation if, with malicious intention toward the race,
11	color, religion [or], national origin <u>or intellectual or</u>
12	physical disability of another individual or group of
13	individuals, he commits an offense under any other provision of
14	this article or under Chapter 33 (relating to arson, criminal
15	mischief and other property destruction) exclusive of section
16	3307 (relating to institutional vandalism) or under section 3503
17	(relating to criminal trespass) with respect to such individual
18	or his or her property or with respect to one or more members of
19	such group or to their property.

(c) Definition.--As used in this section "malicious
intention" means the intention to commit any act, the commission
of which is a necessary element of any offense referred to in
subsection (a) motivated by hatred toward the race, color,
religion [or], national origin or intellectual or physical
<u>disability</u> of another individual or group of individuals.
Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
